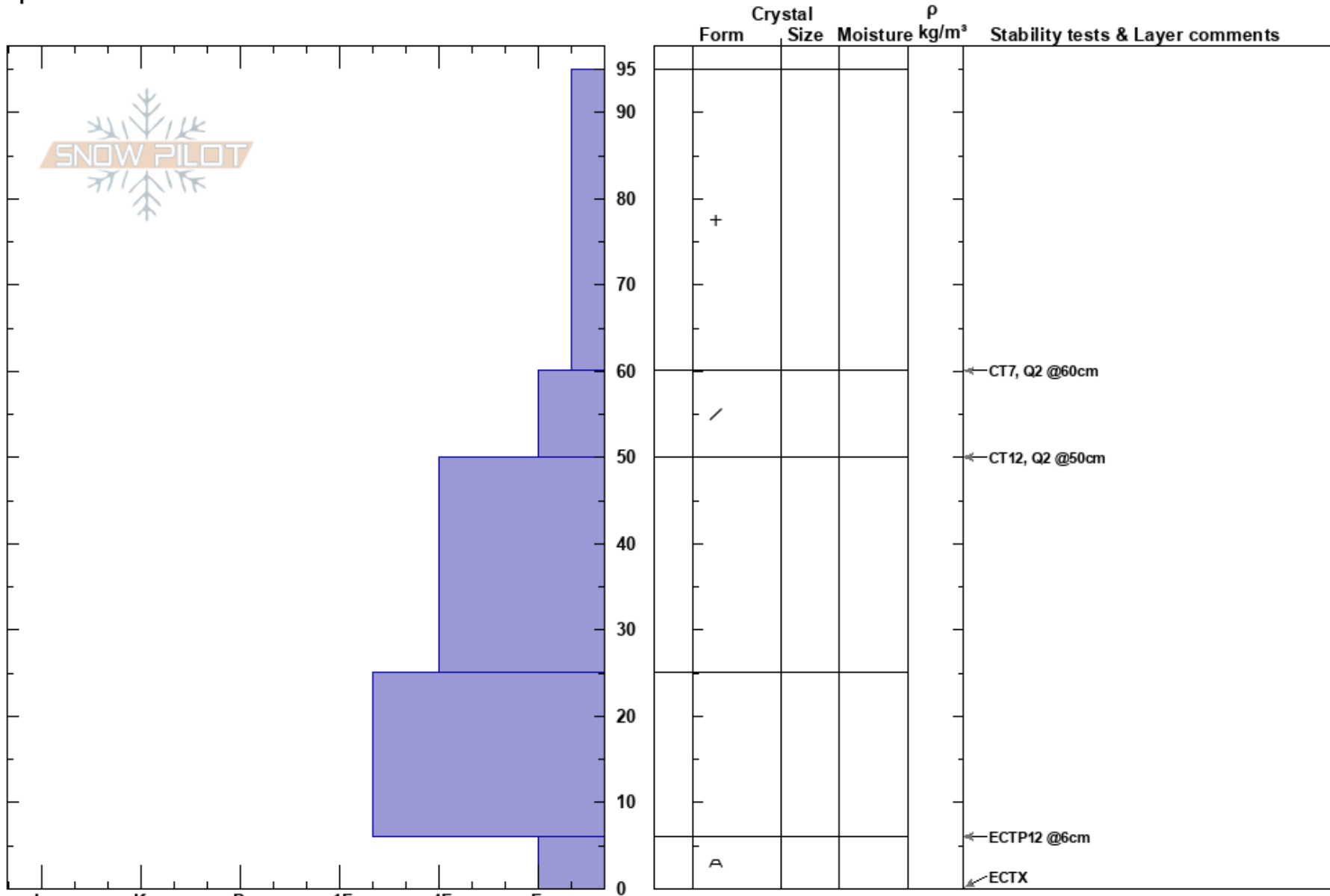

**Notes:** The basal facet layer is so thin, in most locations it's not continuous over the terrain, broken by rocks and vegetation. I think there are only isolated places, with smooth ground like rock slabs or grass, where you could connect enough snow for a slide to fail on the depth hoar.
