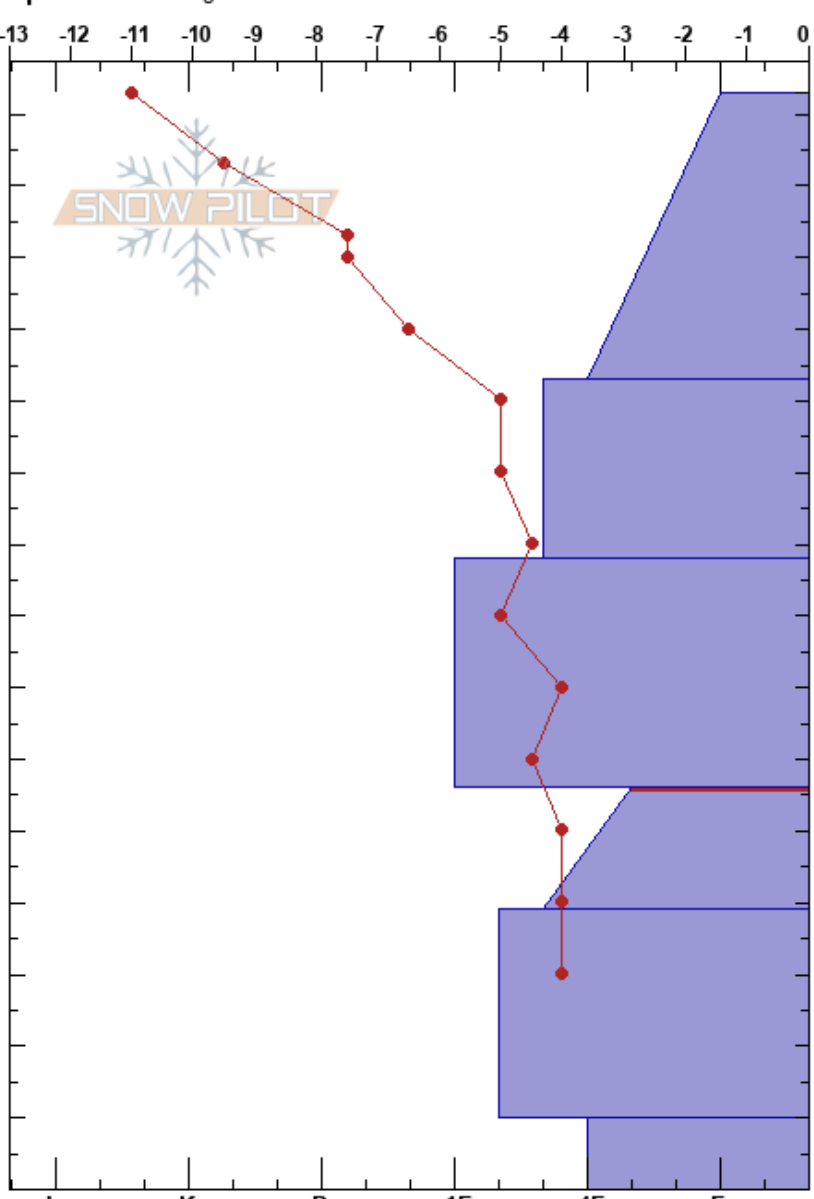

Notes: Pit was dug between 1lb bomb holes (within 80 yards either side). Problem layer is the top of the November near surface facets. The top of this layer is significantly less dense than the bottom and was likely modified by the November 18-22 dry spell.
