

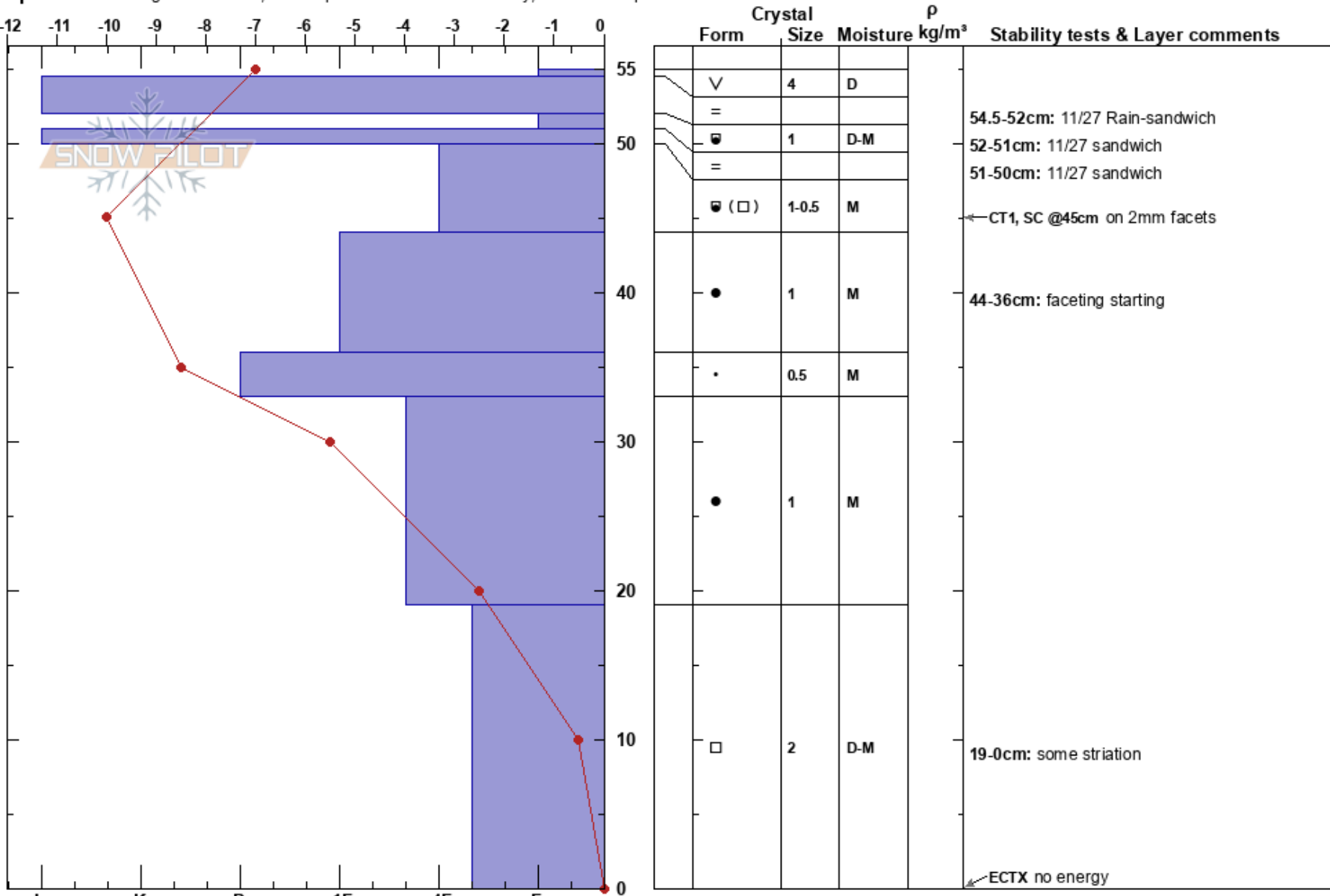

Notes: Previous NE wind scoured down to 11/27 rain crust. 4mm surface hoar overnight almost attached to surface of semi-breakable crust. Ski pen only 2cm but boot pen 41cm. First pit of the season to see how current cold temps affecting early season pack and gauge how additional load will affect. Additional Layer Comments: 0-19cm: Problematic layer;
