

**Notes:** Dug near the top of Nitwits, 20 yards below and skier's left of the standard entrance. This part of the slope likely did not release during the November 25th avalanche cycle whereas further down (mid slope and skiers left) did release after that loading event. Structure is relatively poor yet stability is relatively good right now. Phil dug a hasty pit further down near the suspected location of the November 25th crown and got an ECTX result.
