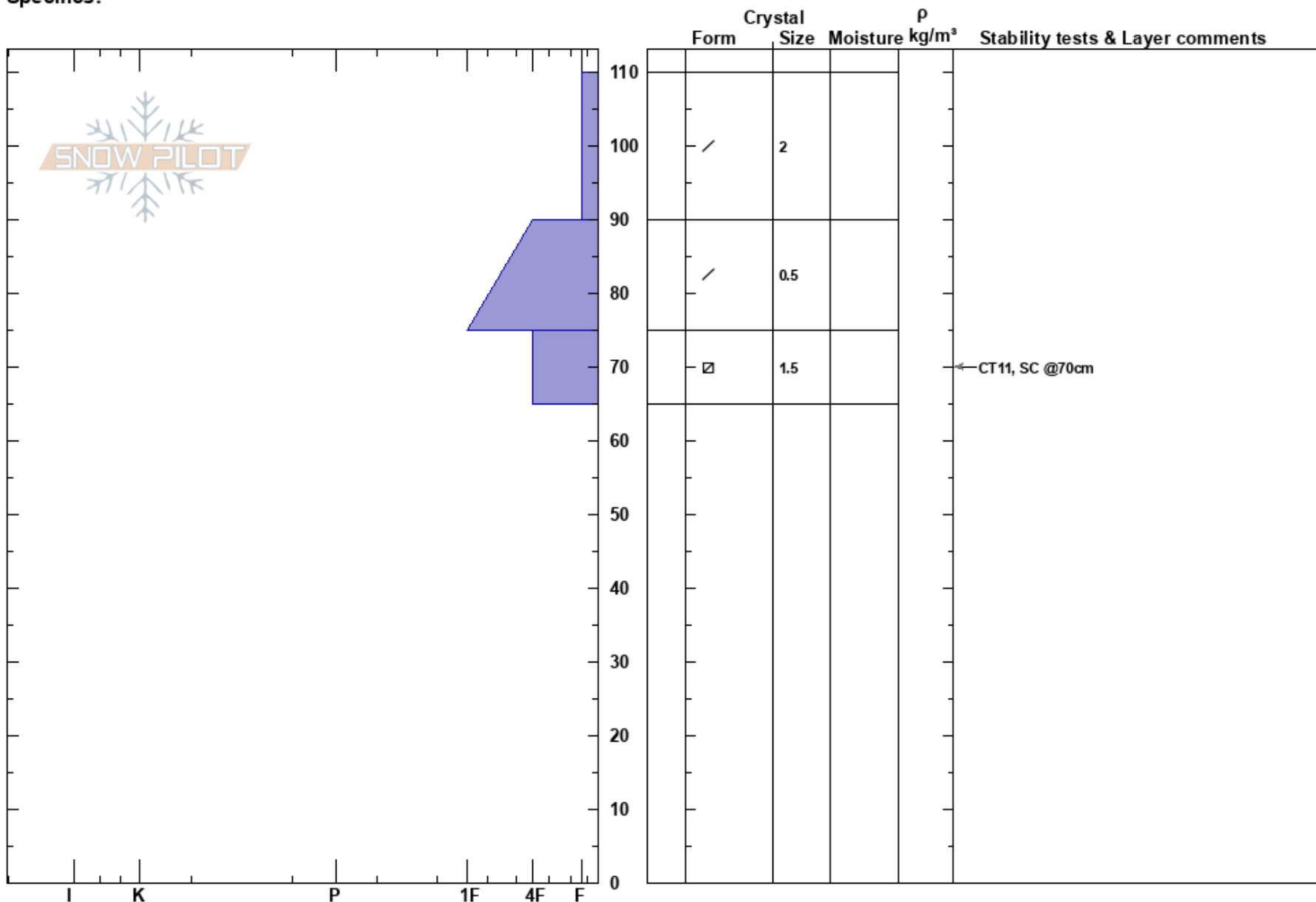

The slide had a 50' wide start zone with ESE aspect. On E facing terrain just skier's left, I didn't see the MF crust that formed the bed surface for the slide.
