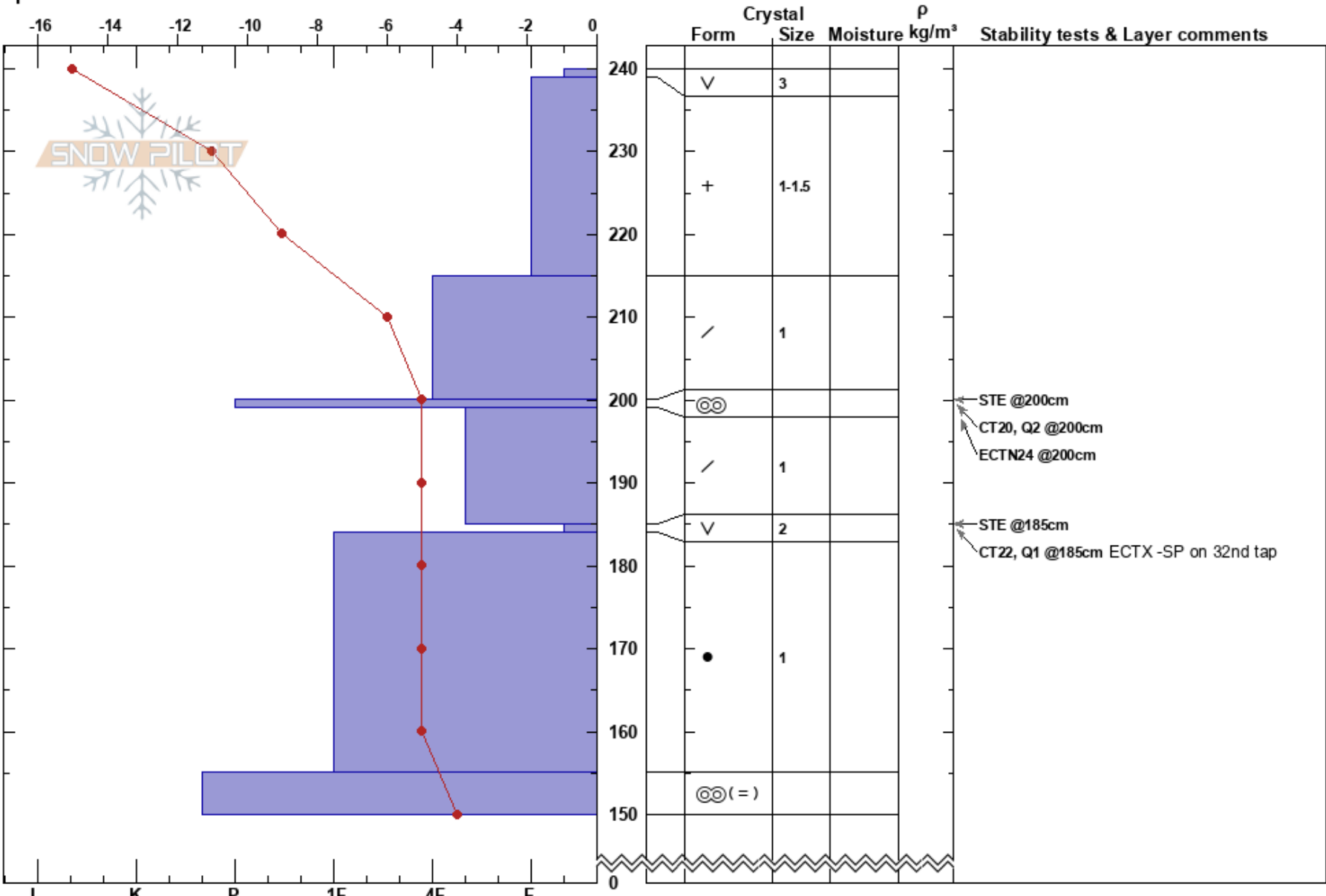

**Notes:** Sheltered location looking for reactivity of buried SH that was a culprit 12/30. Avalanches reported throughout the day on SH layer. We heard collapsing in the afternoon on NE aspects between 6k and 6,200 ft and remotely triggered a small slide on that aspect/elevation too. SH buried about 60 cm deep persists above 6k despite the 12/28-12/29 rain event.
