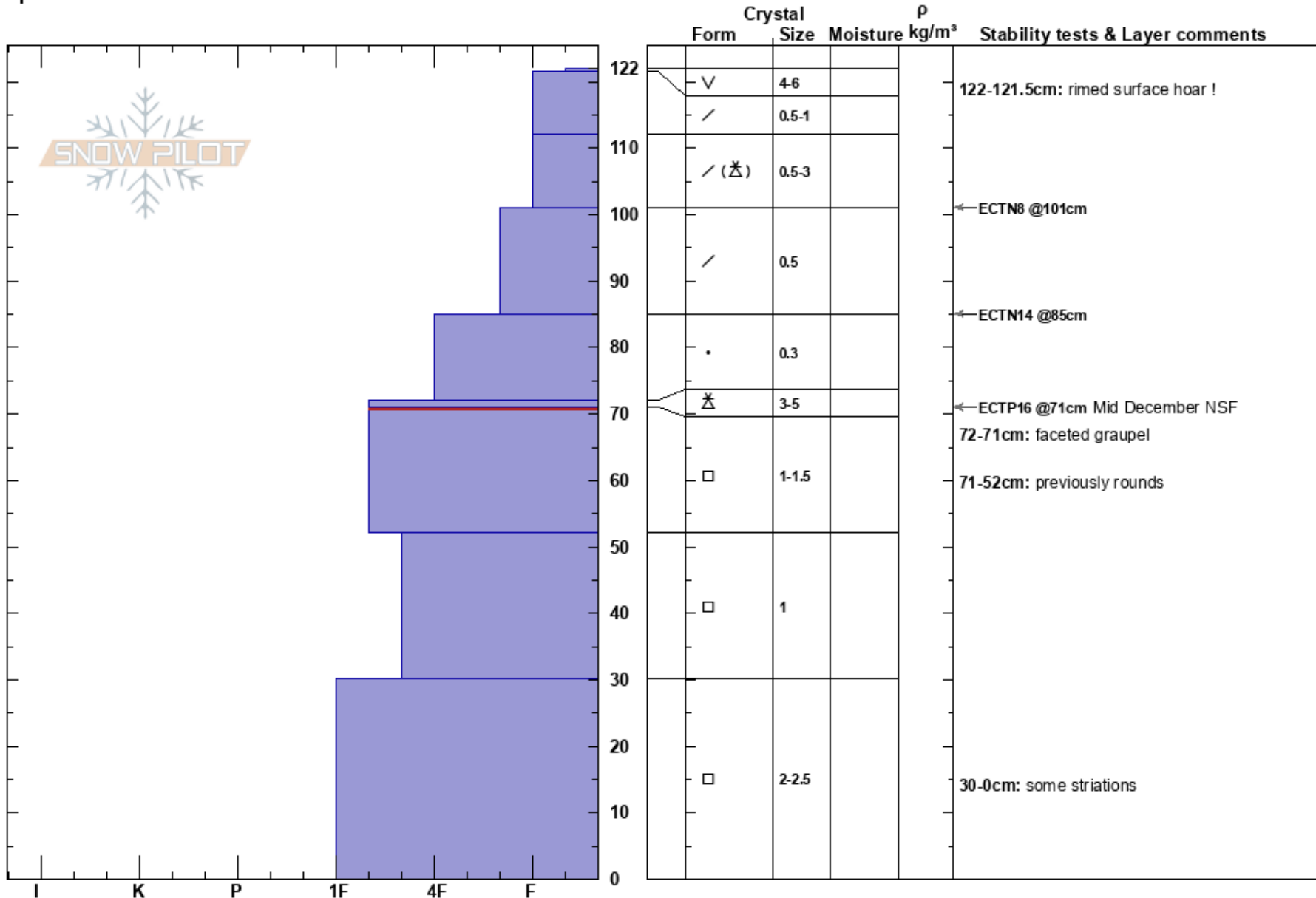

West facing trees on Oliver have a generally rotten base with no slab above. Not a great structure in the trees for future loading.
