

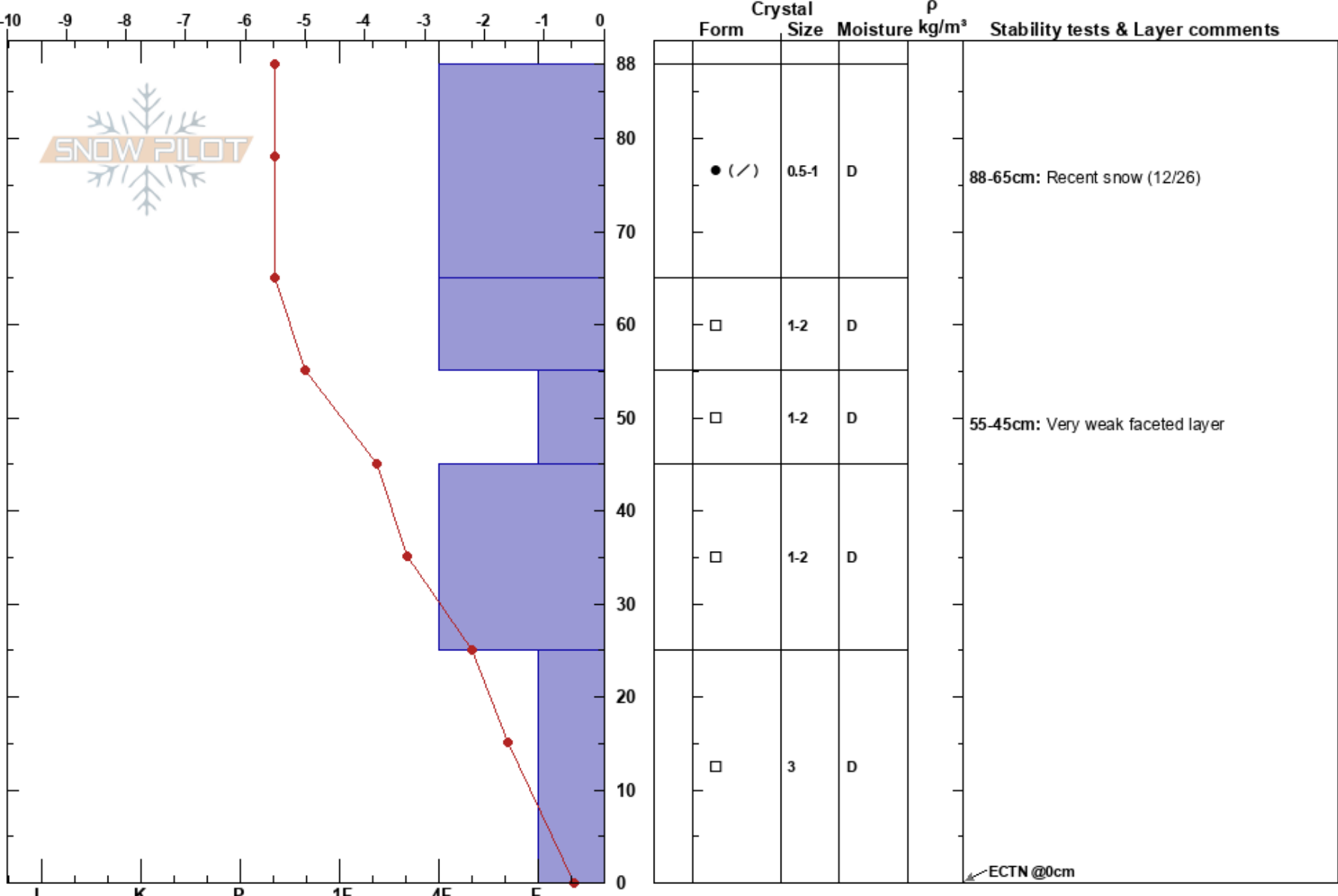

Specifics: Collapsing, widespread; Instability rapidly rising; We skied slope



**Notes:** We noted a very weak snowpack structure on nearly all aspects in Hellroaring Canyon in the Centennials. Huge layers of facets underly a very thin snowpack. Although we did not get positive ECT results at 7,800', we believe there just hasn't been enough slab deposited on top of this weak structure to activate it. These persistent weak layers are very large and widespread. New and/or rapid snow loading should not be taken lightly.
