

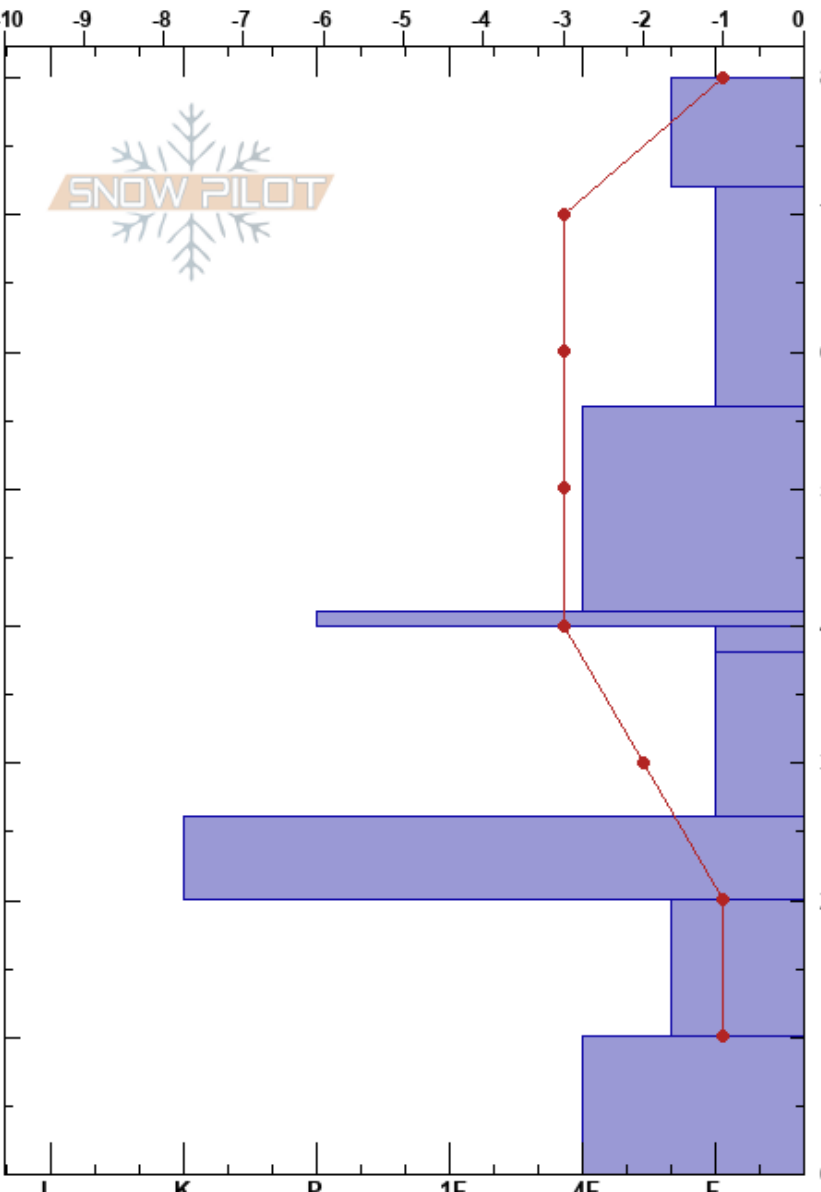

Notes: Pit dug below natural avalanche that hit the road yesterday. I estimated that the avalanche broke below the crust at 40 cm. It may be a rime crust.
