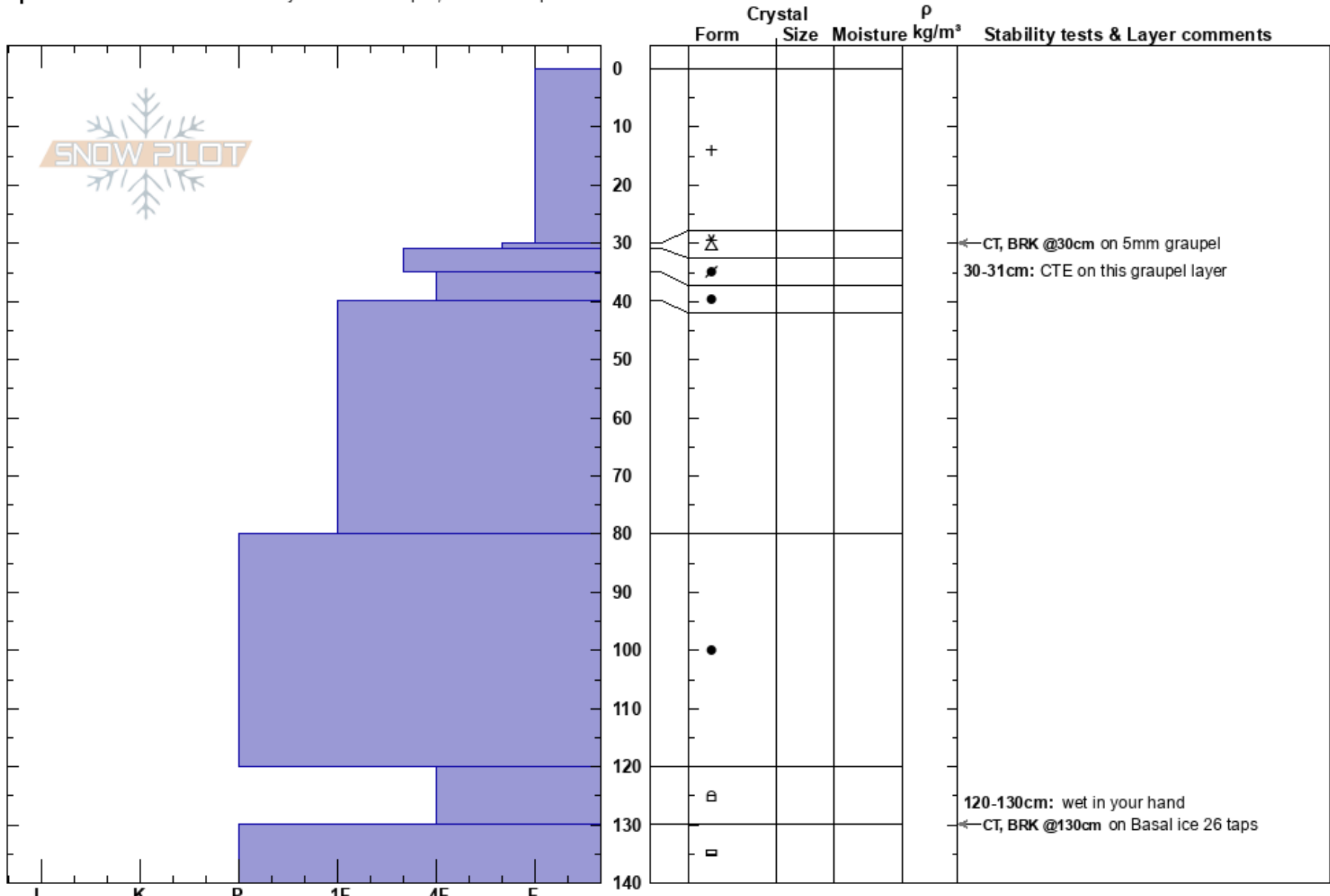

**Notes:** Big plumes of snow blowing off of the tops of the big exposed Peaks like South Bruin we witnessed repeated large plumes of snow heading North from the South wind gusts.
