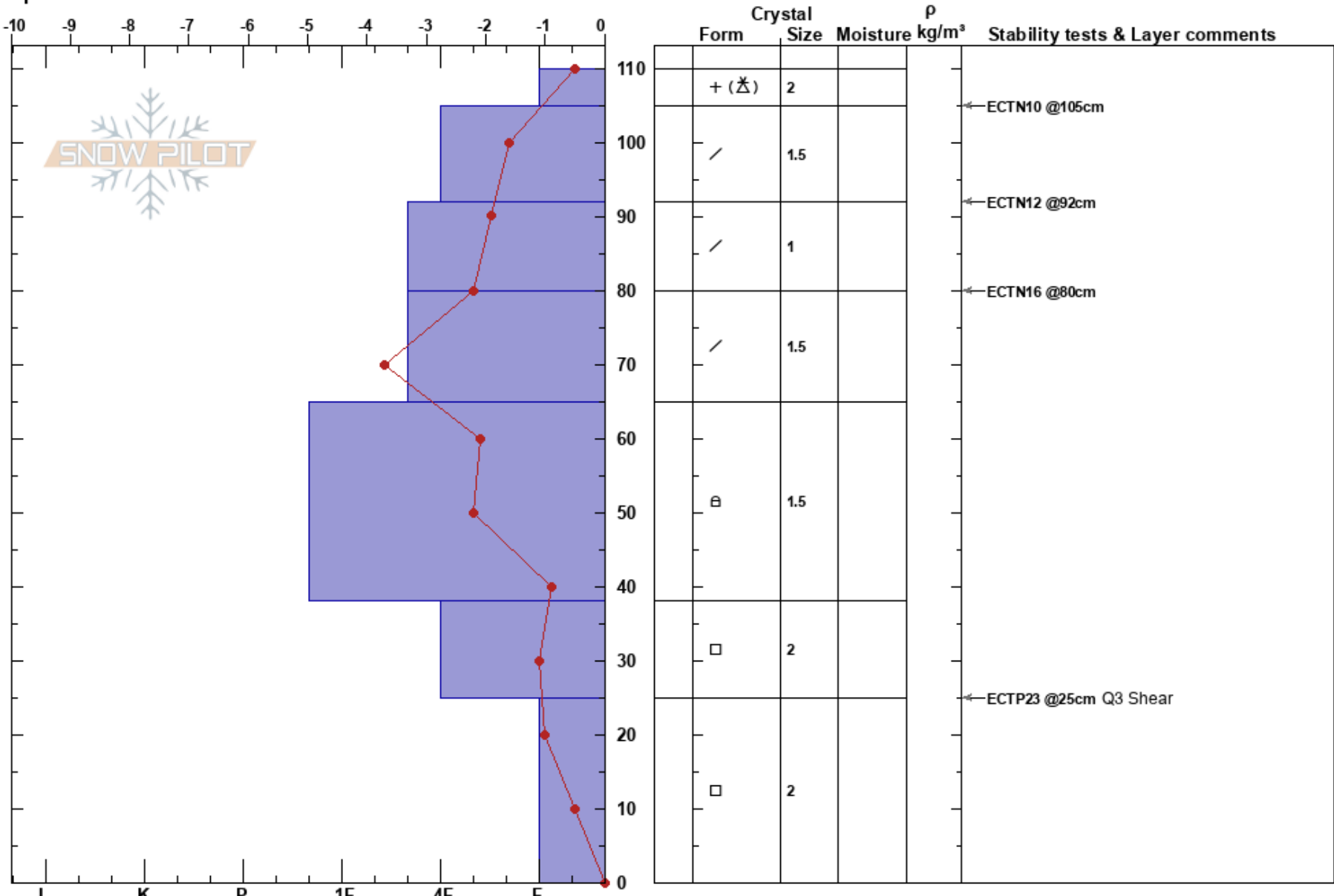

**Notes:** Still a relatively shallow snowpack, the recent warm temps seem to have helped the upper layers, but basal facets are still present, and more concerning, they actually propagated in an ECT in this pit, albeit with a good bit of force and a very poor quality shear. Overall things seem to be improving, but still a very questionable, very weak incohesive layer right above ground in our snowpack.
