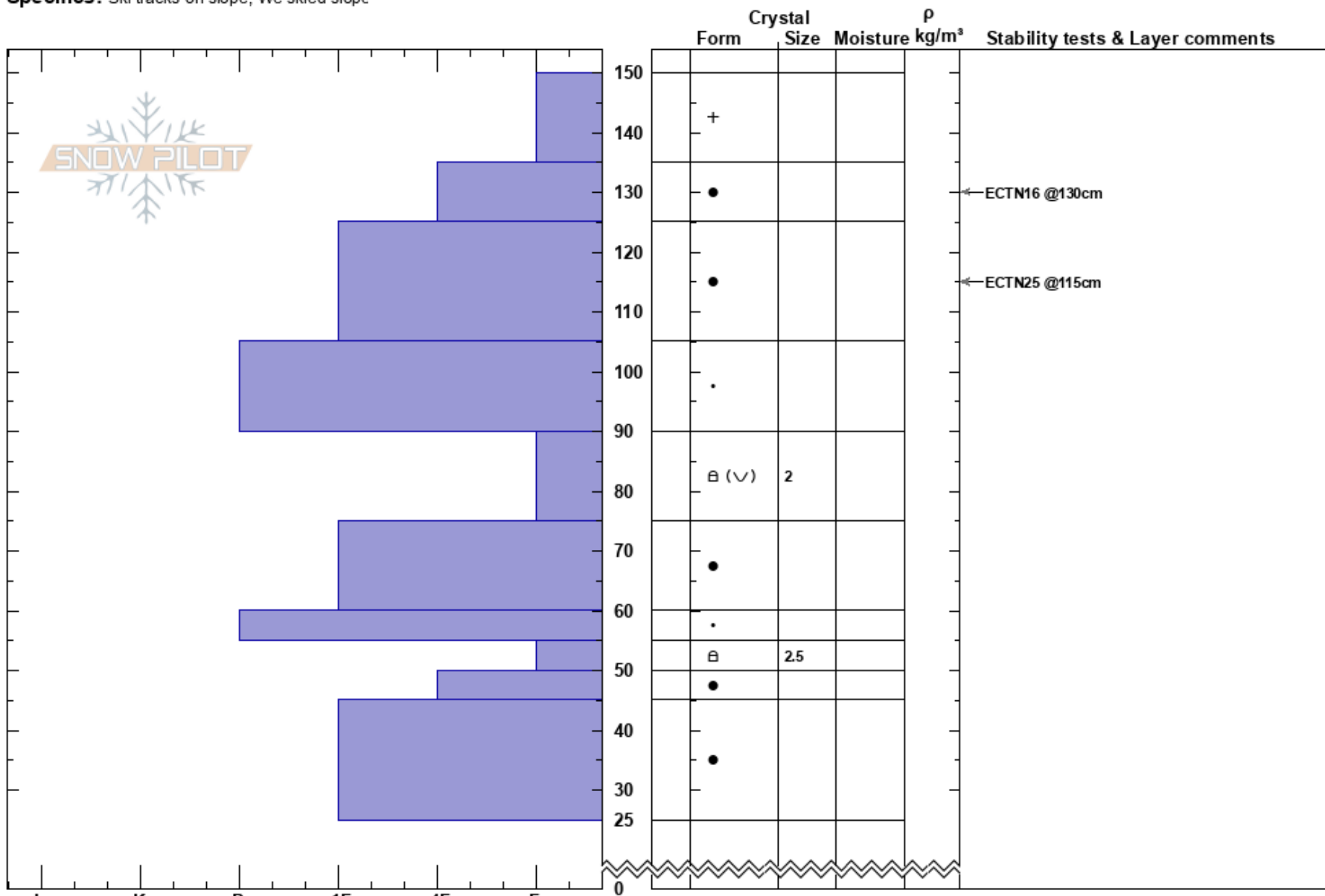

We were very surprised to not see any fracture or propagation on the layer of concern at 75-90cm. Crystal identification in this layer revealed possible buried surface hoar that was rounding.
