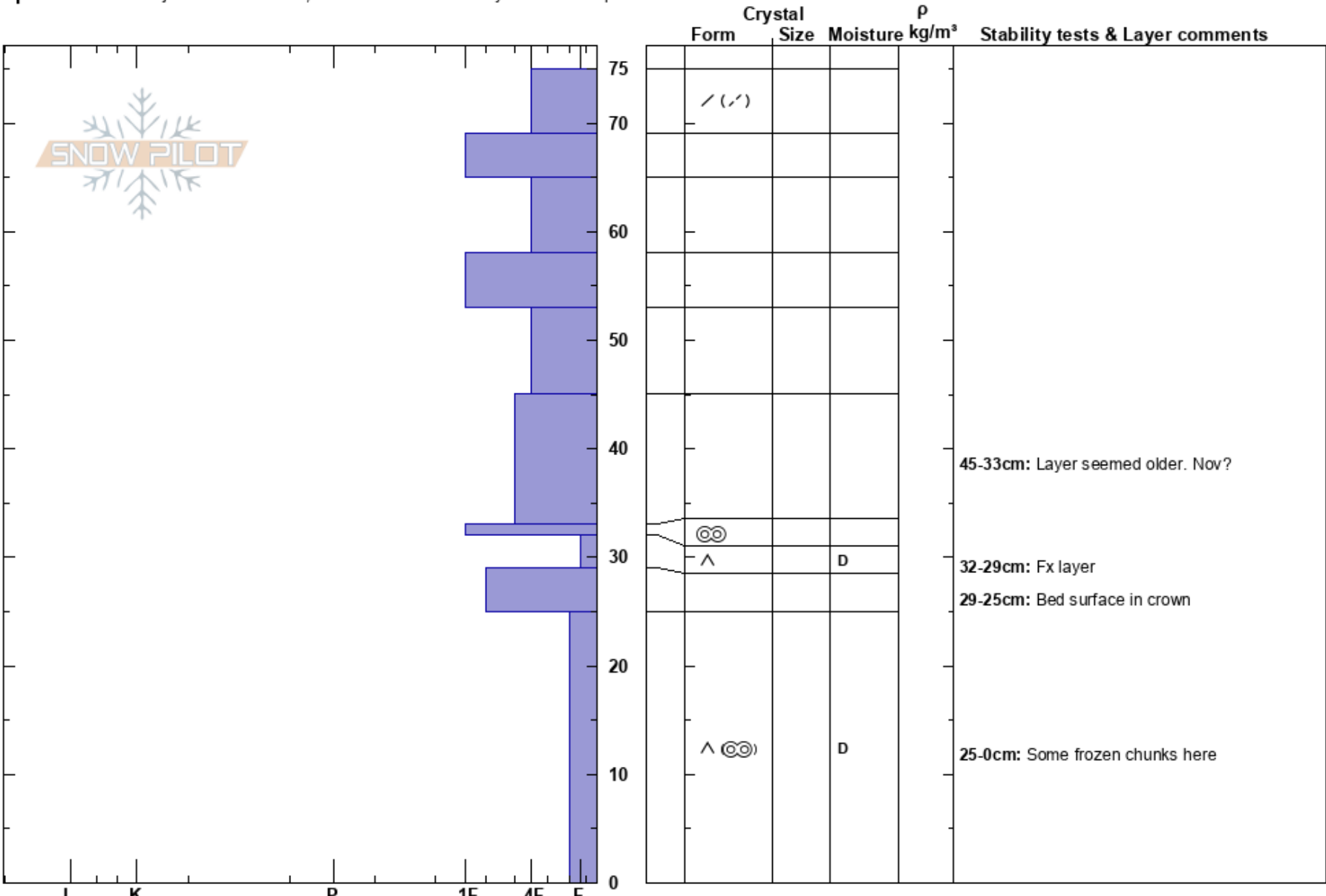

**Notes:** Dug in thinner part of crown roughly above where slide triggered. Crown face height varied noticeably within 20 m of profile site - 1 to 4+ ft. Basal DH thinner a few feet away. In profile, crust @ 28 was bed surface, but could easily have been FC below elsewhere. Time and conditions (winds) prevented more detailed profile.
