

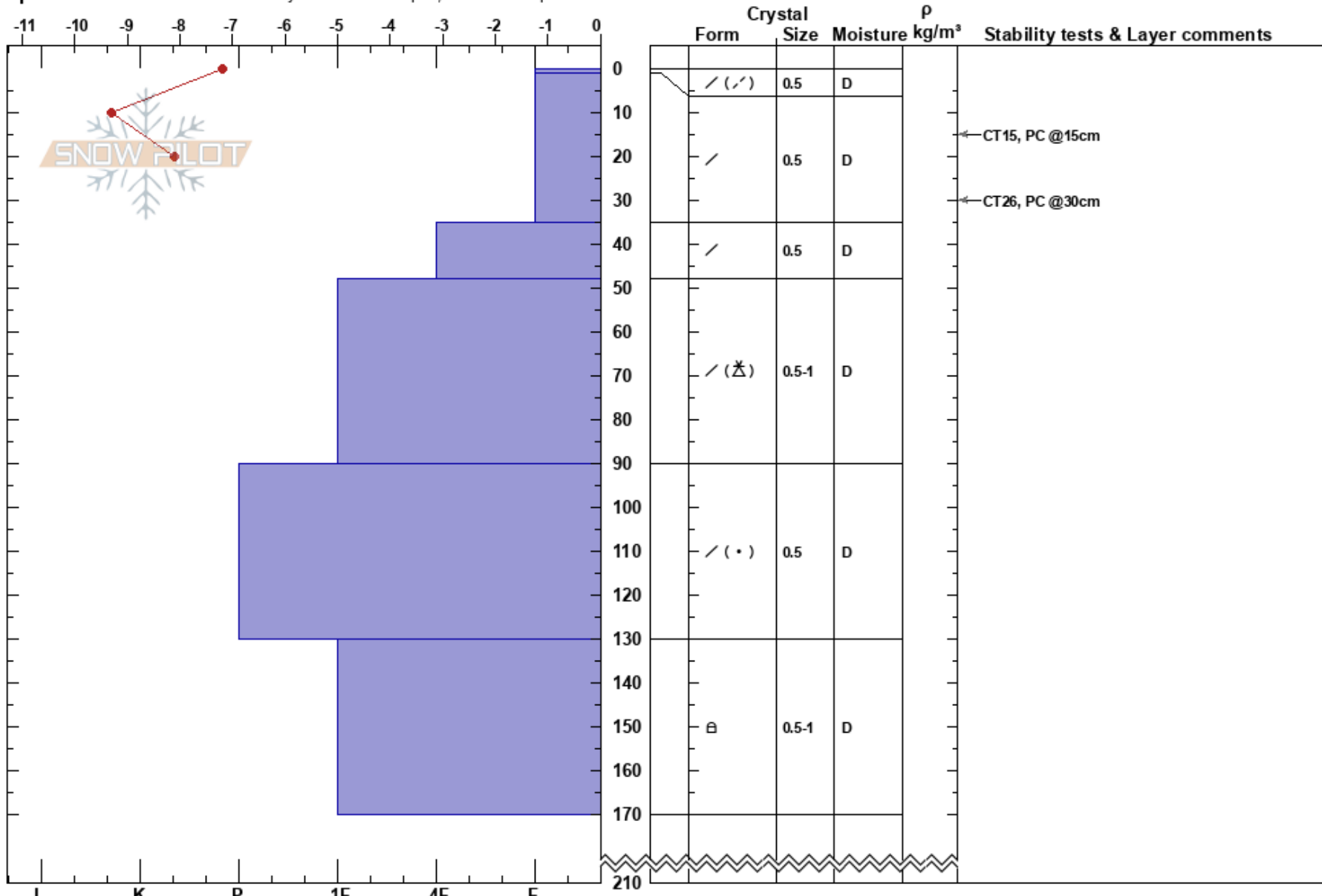

 first few clear days since a little over a stormy week with heavy PI, big HST and strong winds contributing to transport. Large avalanches widespread, mostly triggered with explosives in wind loaded areas, seeing signs of PWL being overloaded as many of the slides are failing at/near the ground.
