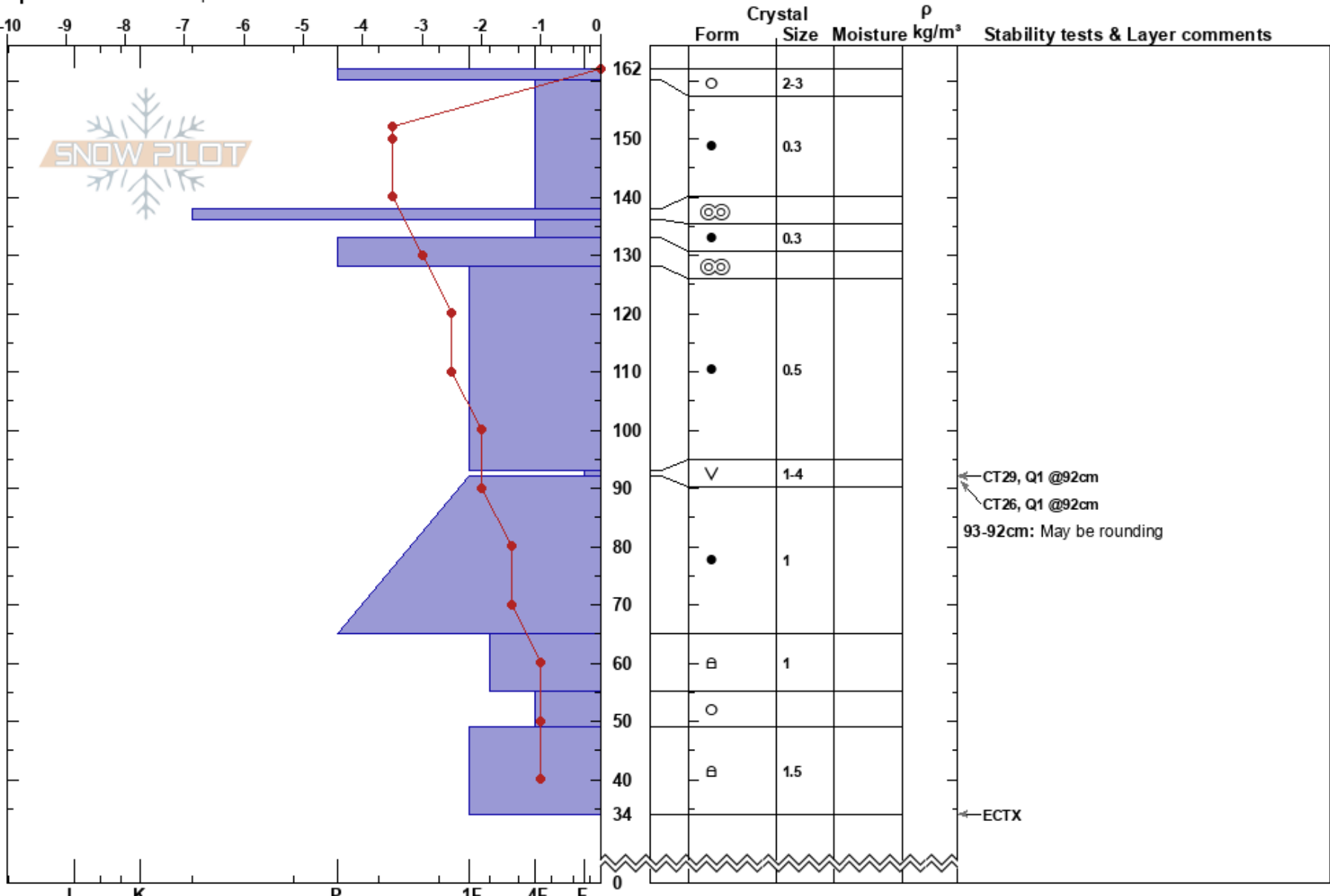

**Notes:** The layer of buried surface hoar was clearly visible on the pit wall. It was about 0.5cm thick, but I created an entire layer for it because my CTs failed on that layer. The surface hoar crystals appeared to be rounding, but I was unsure if that was due to air temperatures while exposed. I gave it a F hardness, but it was tough to discern.
