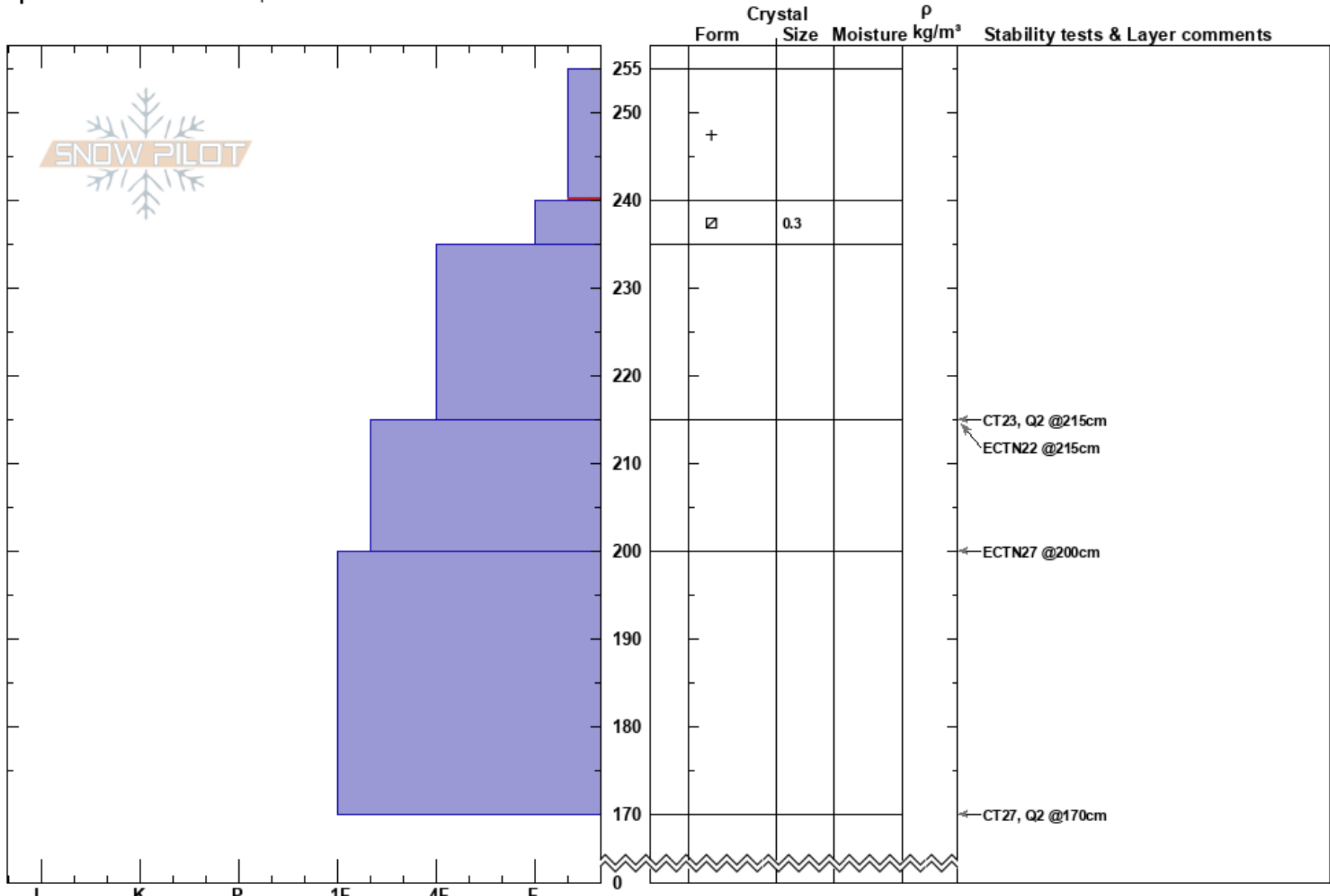

**Notes:** Fewer layers seen in this pit compared to lower elevations in Silver Fork. Weakest snow is the new snow of large, fragile stellars. When we got above treeline in an area with just a little wind, the new snow sluffed very easy and ran far distances. More snow and more wind overnight will mean more dry loose avalanches and sensitive wind slabs.
