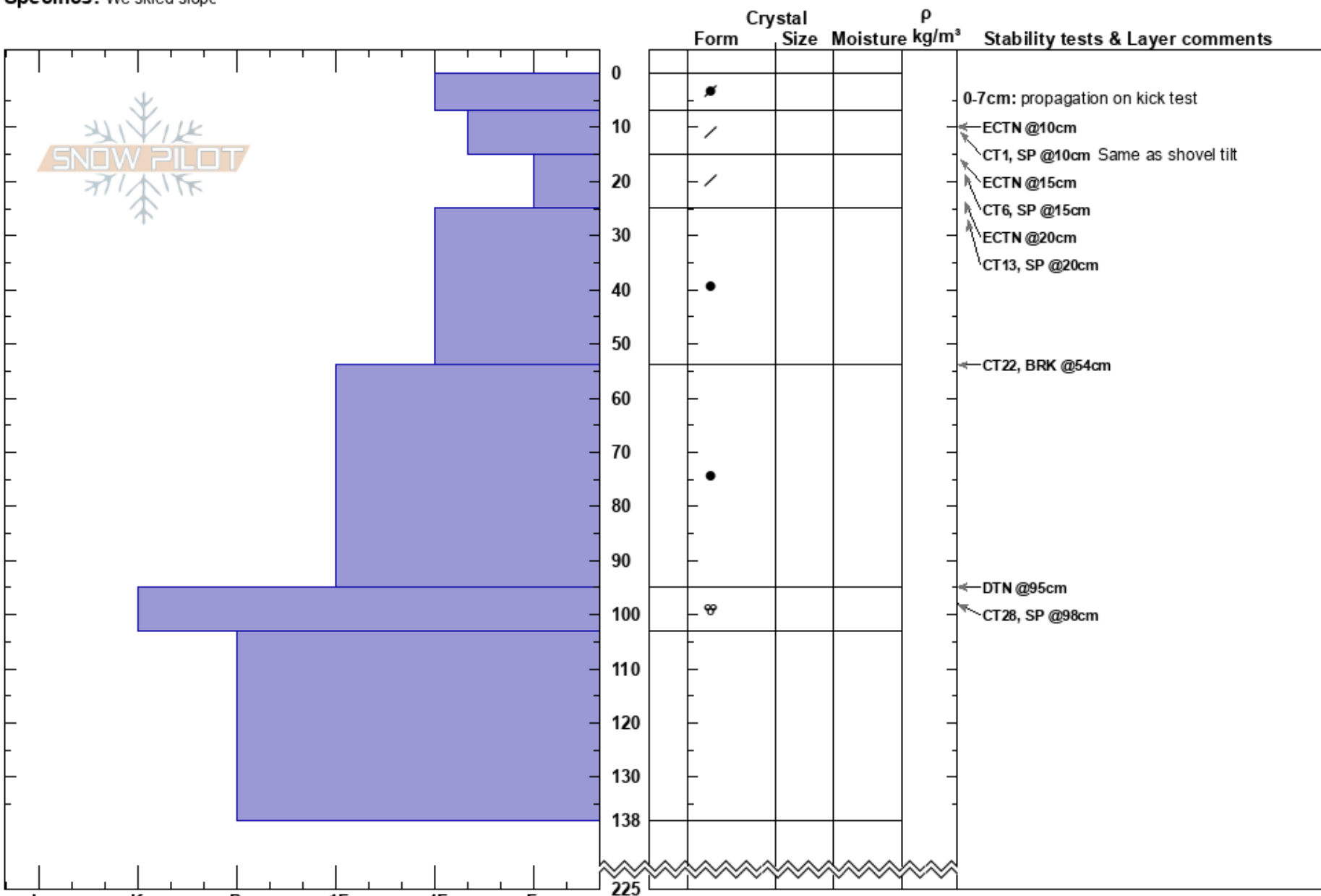

**Notes:** Gusts to moderate. Moderate to high W to SW winds off the Dana Plateau. Visible snow transport down into the gullies on E. Peak of Dana, Coke- and Ripper Chutes. Did not see any evidence of natural avalanches during the weekend storm. Active wind loading ATL and NTL the whole time we were out until 1530. The snow BTL was mostly unaffected by the winds. Most evidence of instability was observed in the top 10 to 15 cm of the snowpack. Kick tests propagated and the soft wind slab broke into blocks.
