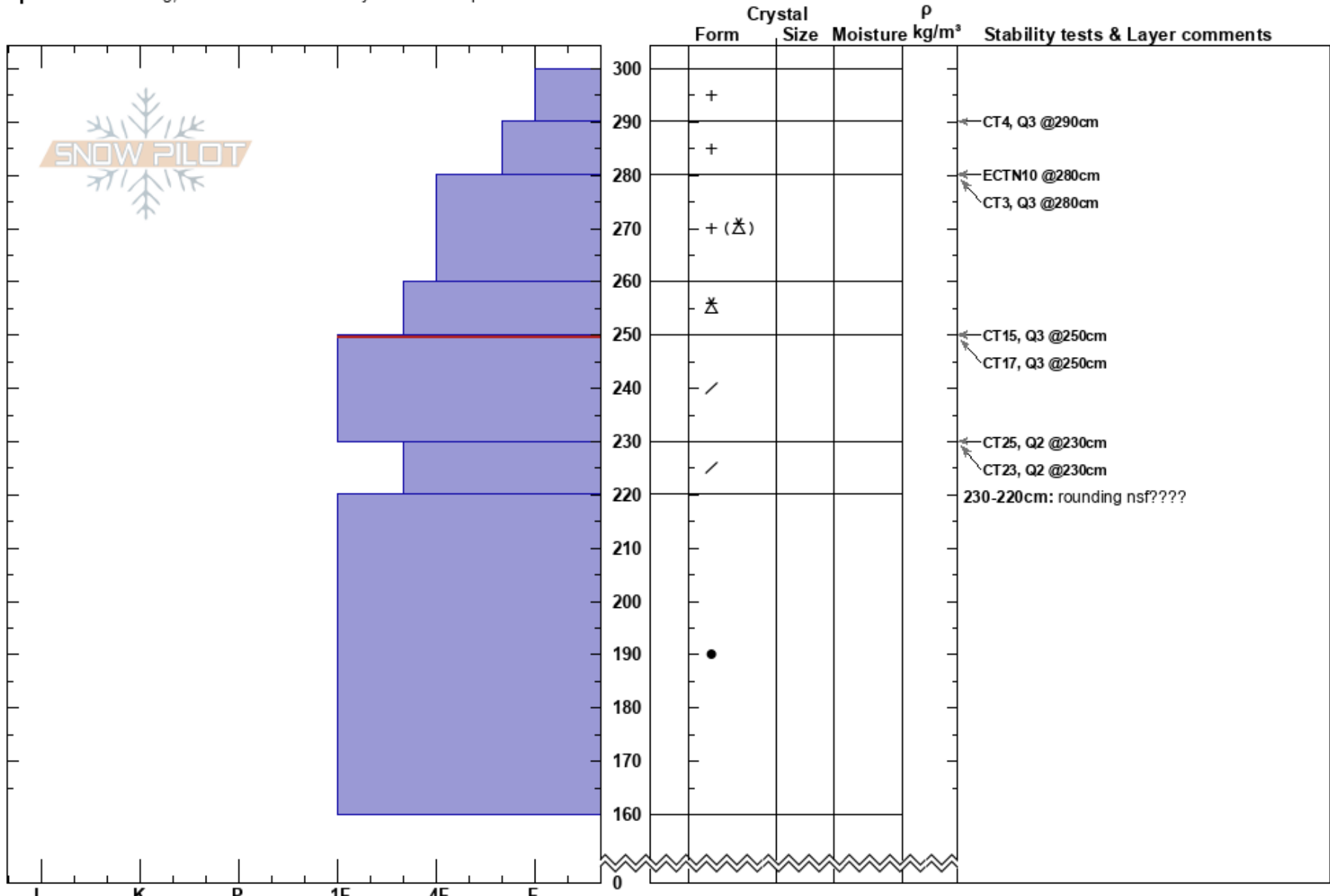

**Notes:** Ski cut a soft slab on a steeper test slope near the pit site. It fractured 20 cm deep on graupel, and 40 feet wide. Significant natural activity in the northern paths about 38 hours prior to digging this pit. Those avalanches fractured about 1-1.5 meters deep on buried nsf.
