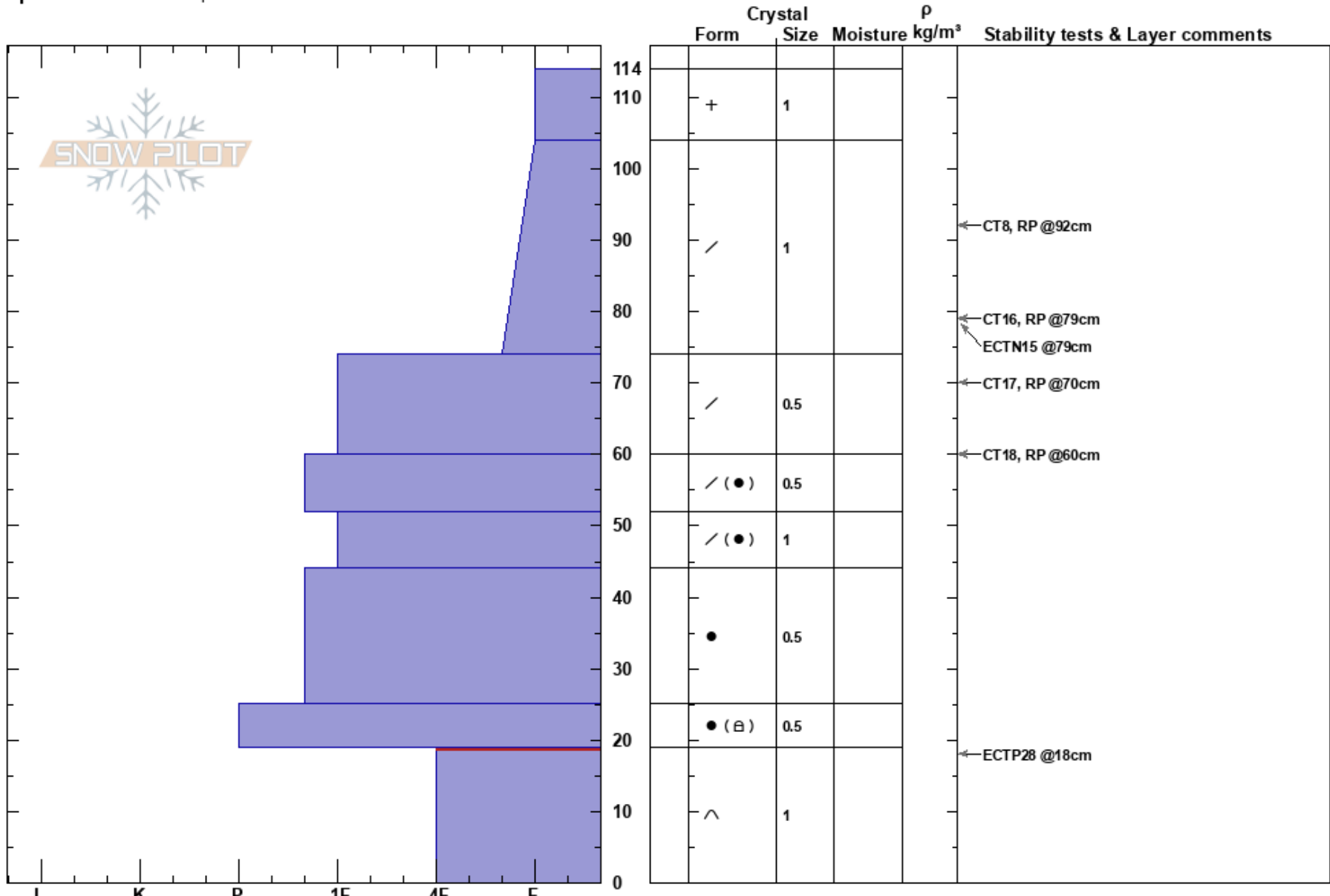

Notes: 1kg AB on slope above broke small cornice but no avalanche. Slope previously failed Feb 15 HS-N-R4,D3-O 6'deep, 1300' wide and it seems that most of the depth hoar was taken in that event. It also left the upper most layer layer of depth hoar hardened as its now P hard and rounded. Feeling like this is the main reason for the good stability and we are finally feeling good about this area. We opened the slope to guided skiing today for the first time this season.
