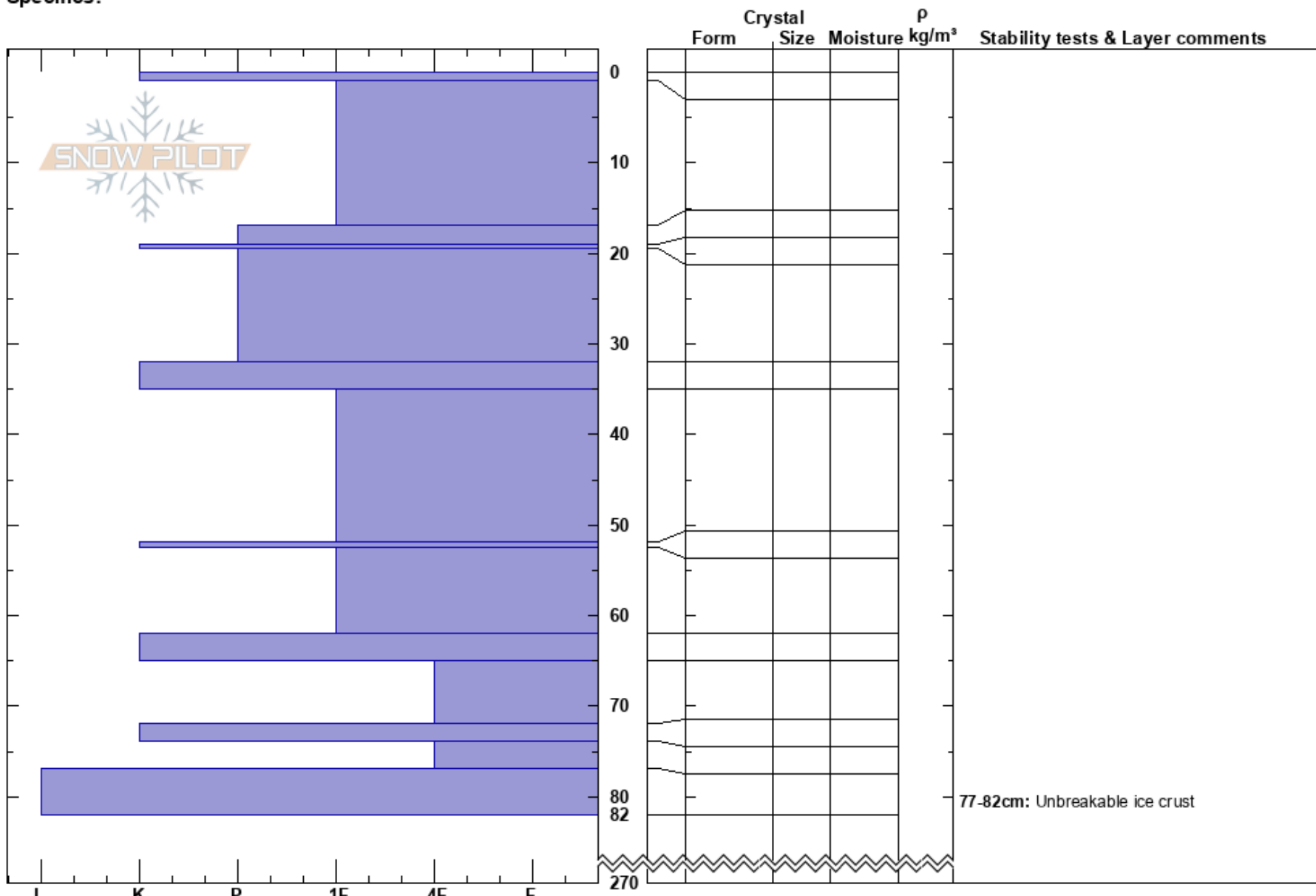

Notes: Pit was located in a snowfield in a pocket in the lee from W winds underneath a rollover. On the rollover (above the pit) were exposed rocks and trees as well as trees exposed 10m below the pit. Unbreakable ice crust 82cm down with many ice crusts within upper 82cm. Potentially caused by rain entering snowpack above pit location on exposed ground and traveling downhill through snow along preexisting layers.
