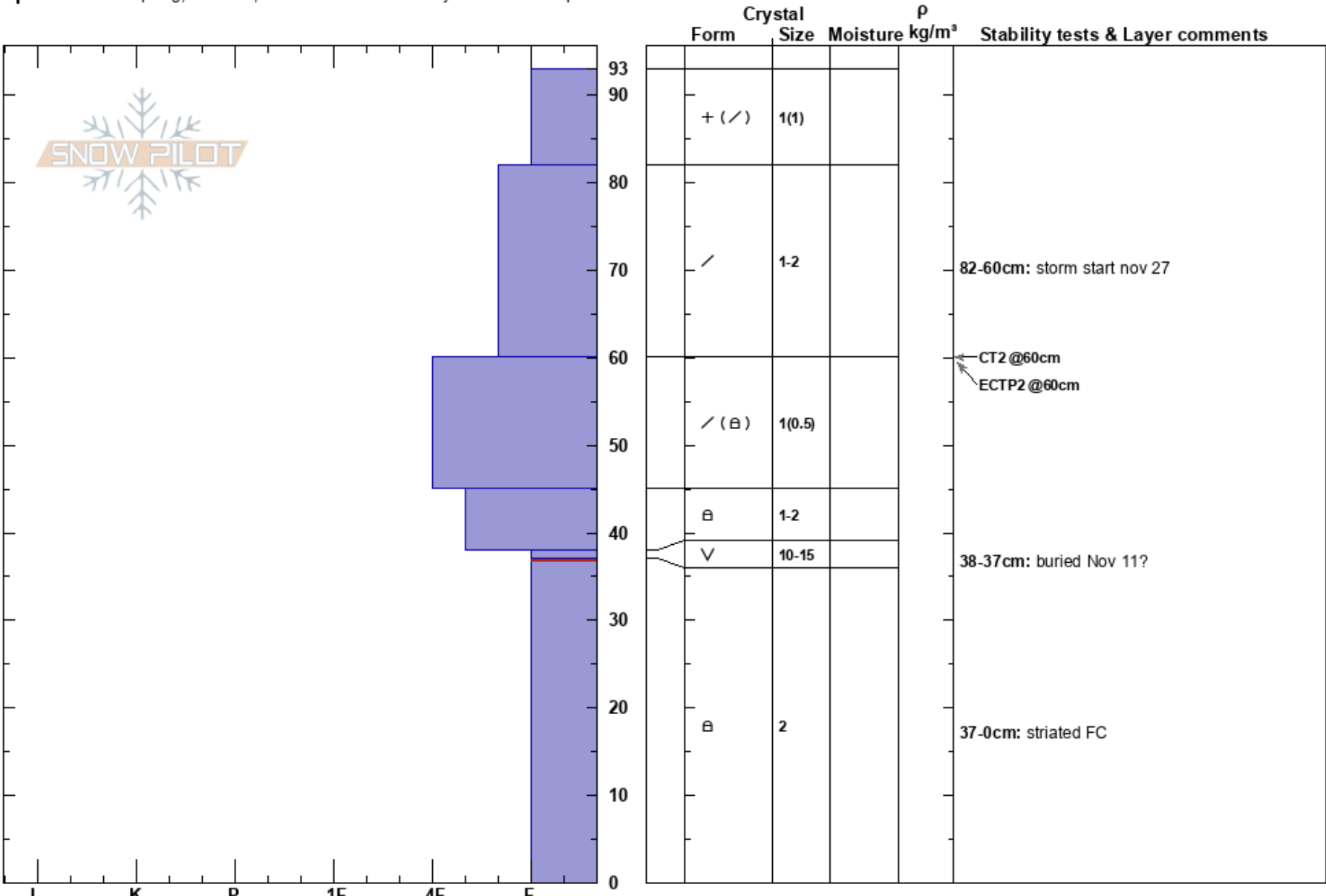

**Notes:** Annual Thanksgiving Pit in standard location at top of KB Ridge - far skier's left of the bowl. Not much slab development, but we did learn that the far skier's right side of the same bowl was skier triggered several hours later. Several collapses on approach and uptrack. Average snowdepth was 90cm, but range was 80-110cm. Much more than ex
