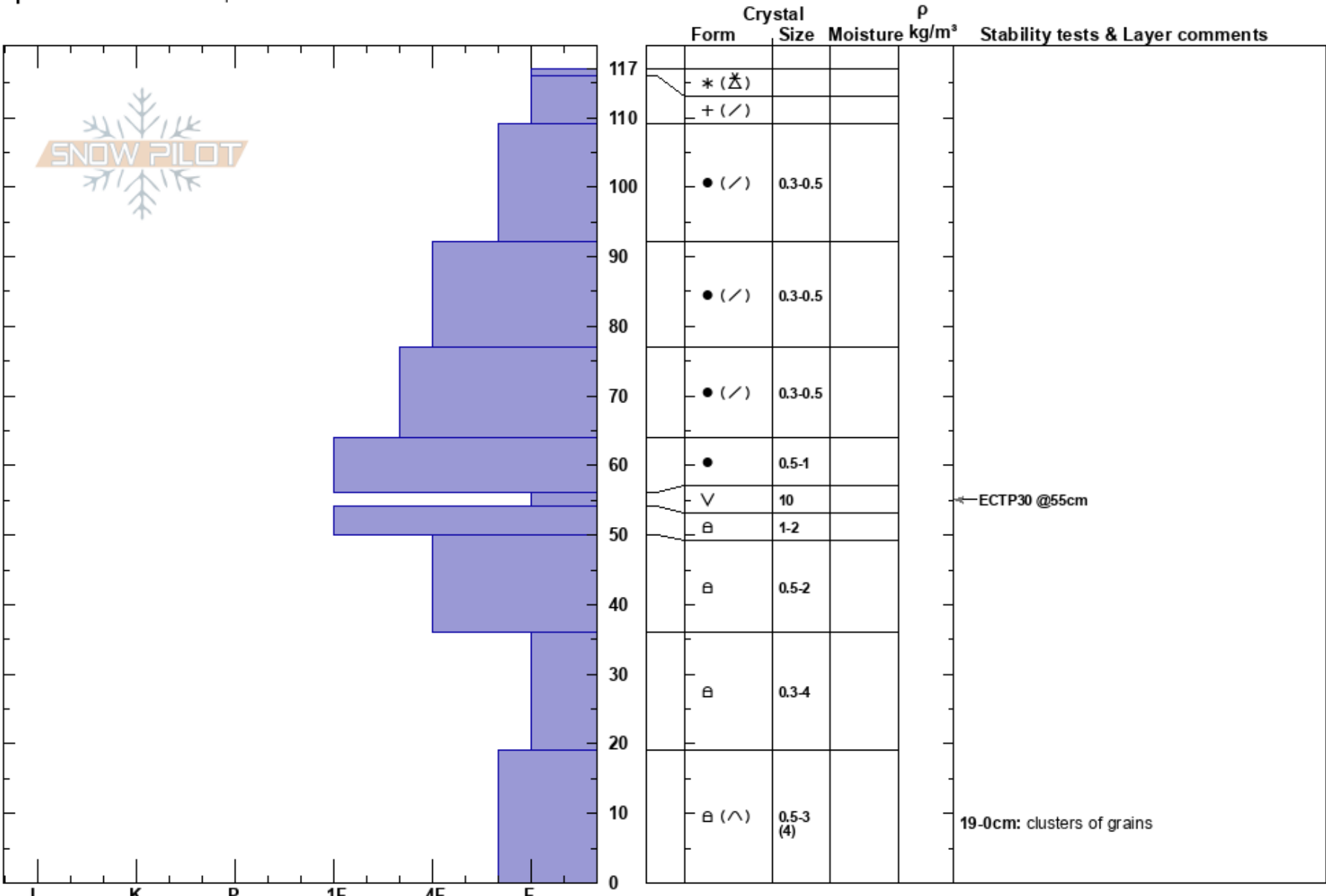

**Notes:** Unknown to me, a group lower on the slope triggered an avalanche while I was digging my pit. This snowpack is very spicy as the snow grains are stronger in compression than shear, causing slopes with ski tracks to avalanche. I am sure groups before me had a collapse in the area where I dug. There have now been 2 avalanches on this slope and it has been heavily skied before and after the most recent slab was added.
