

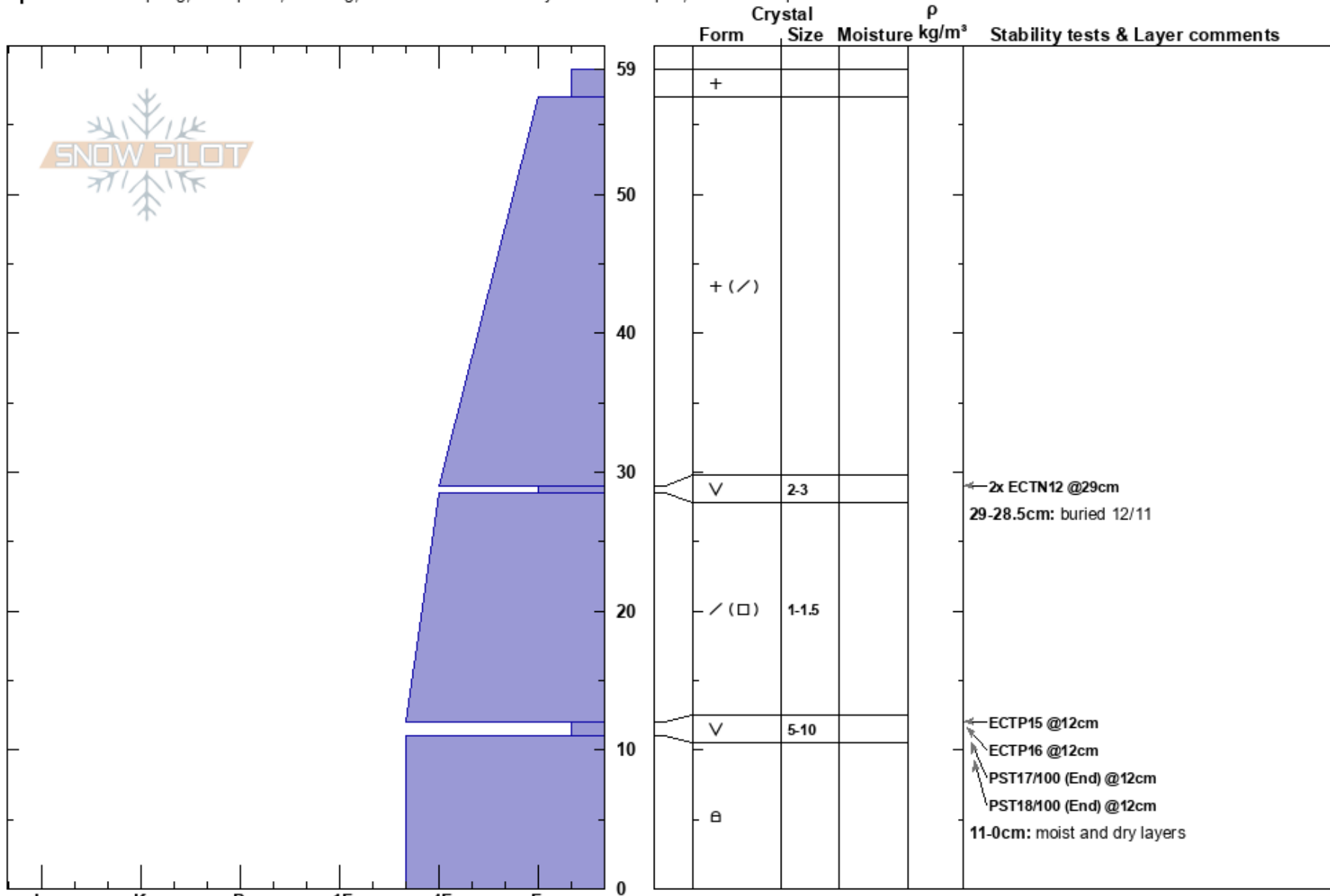

Specifics: Collapsing, widespread; Cracking; Recent avalanche activity on similar slopes; We skied slope



Notes: No pre-Thanksgiving snow in this location. Reactive SH produced long traveling cracks and collapses. Remotely triggered a D2 on this layer (12/7 SH, down about 45cm) about 300m higher in elevation. Remotely triggered a D2.5 at this interface (12/7) that failed on MFCr+FC with a few SH grains visible at crown. S-SE aspect at 10,000'.
