

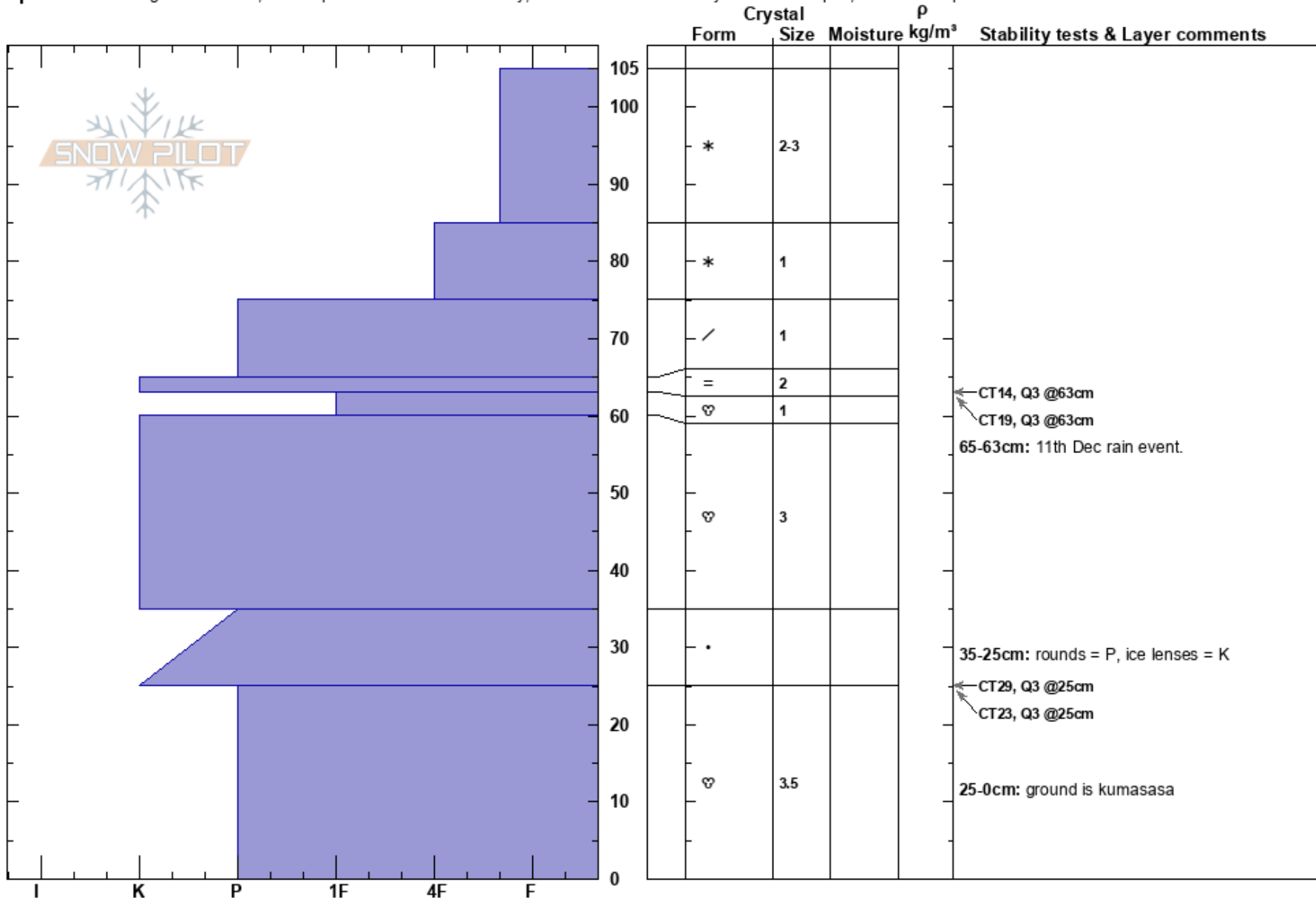

Specifics: Pit dug in a Ski Area; Pit is representative of backcountry; Recent avalanche activity on similar slopes; We skied slope



Notes: Moderate winds, some blowing snow. More sheltered areas lower down would have more snow. Triggered thin, reactive wind slabs below ridge lines in places which suggest dangerous windslabs probably exist above 1000m further up the range. - This windslab layer was not present at this specific location.
