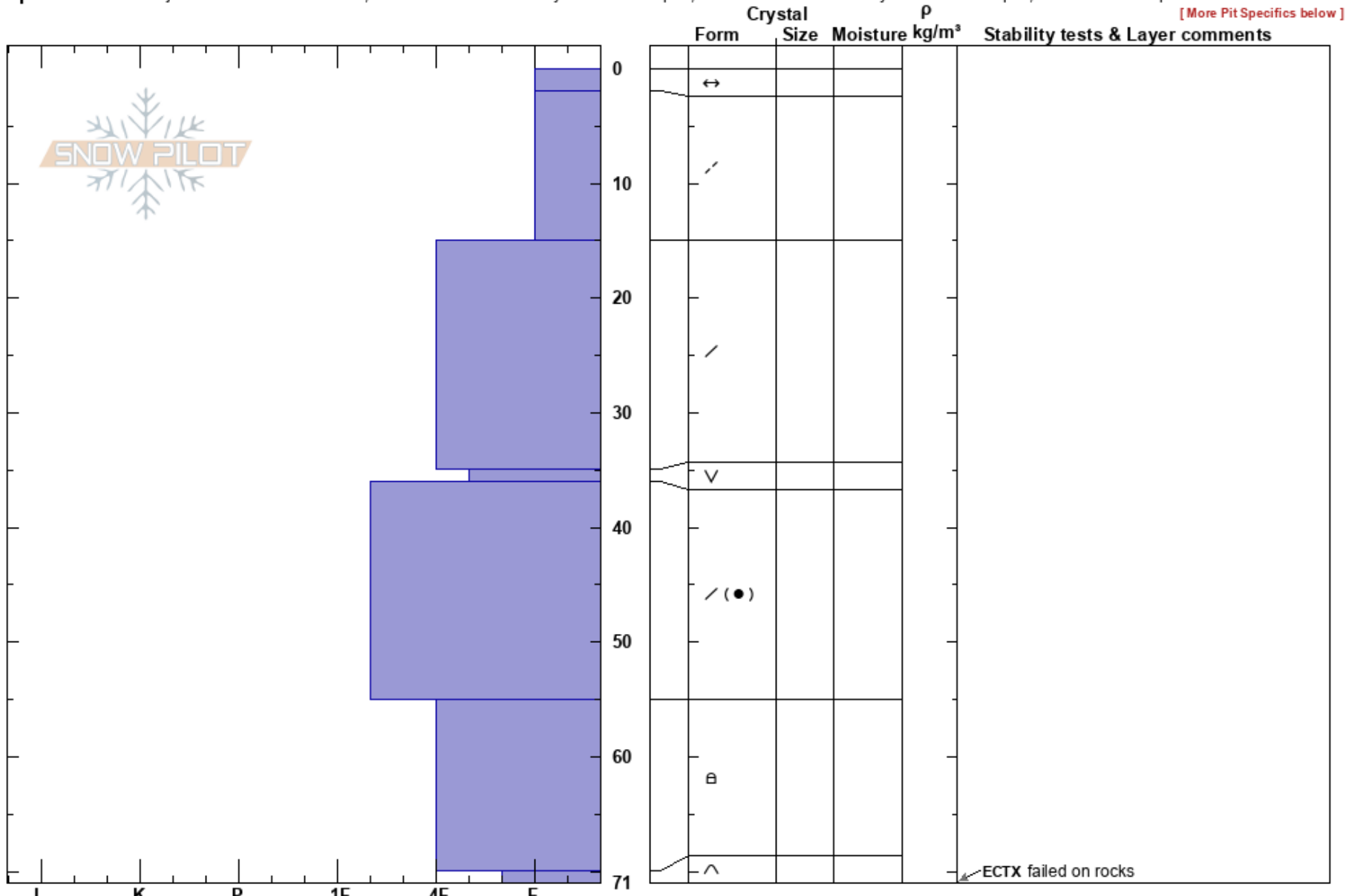

Shallow weak rocky snowpack. Additional Pit Specifics: We skied slope
