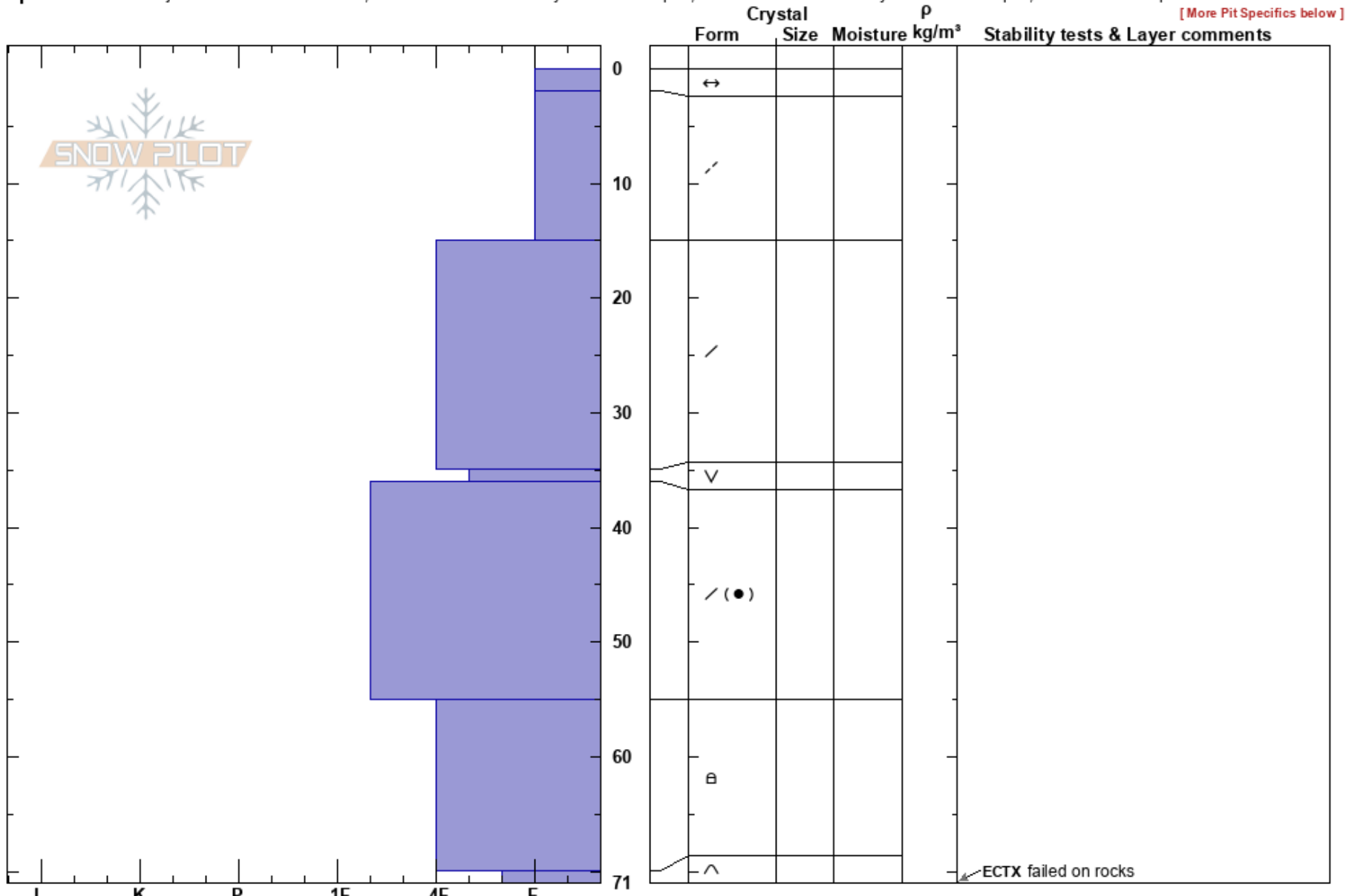

Still reactive on Basal facets and buried surface hoar...shallow and rocky...ECT failed to propagate cause it failed at the ground/rocks/basal facets first but the buried surface hoar is still able to be triggered moderately to difficult, but still potential to propagate. Shallow weak rocky snowpack. Additional Pit Specifics: We skied slope
