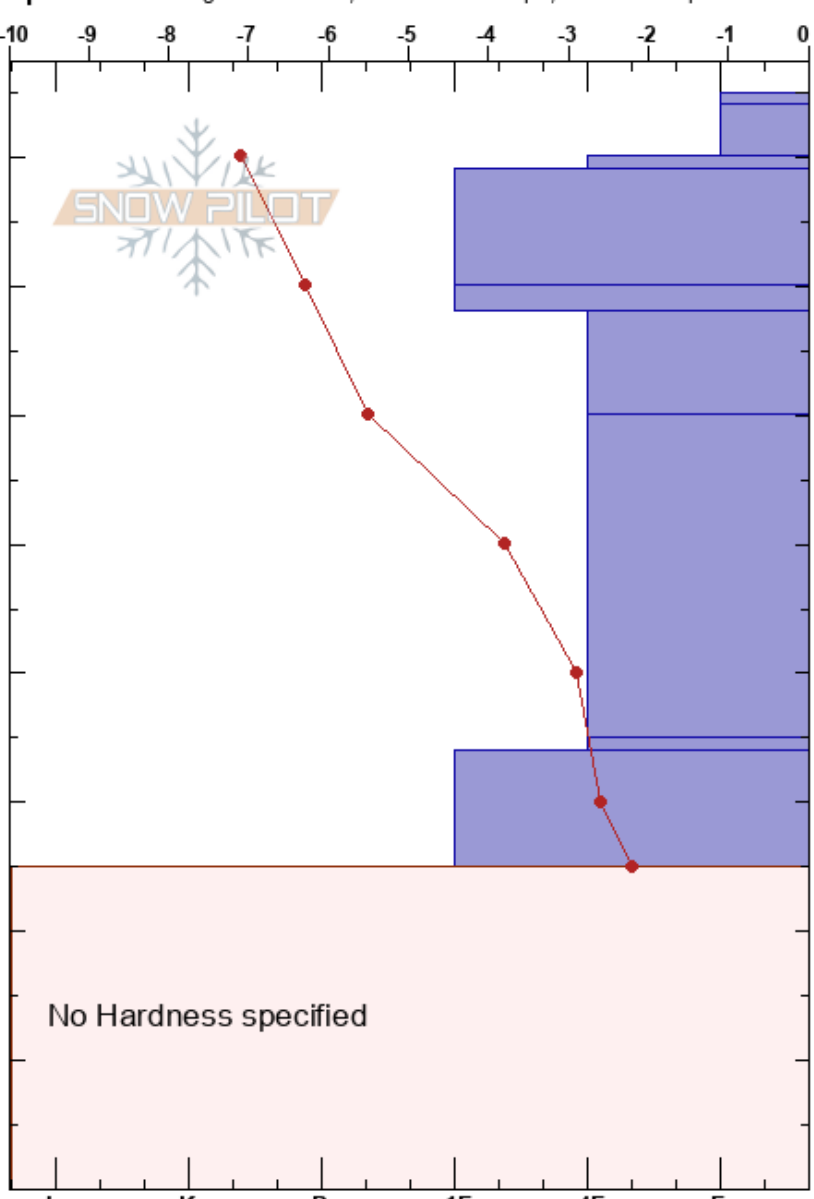

Notes: We were in a location that may have experienced an avalanche previously, causing basal facets to be more affected by the rain during the 12/19-12/21 storm cycle. We dug to the ground, which was very brushy. The ECT test did not slide freely when it broke at the ground (I would consider shear quality to be Q2 because of this).
