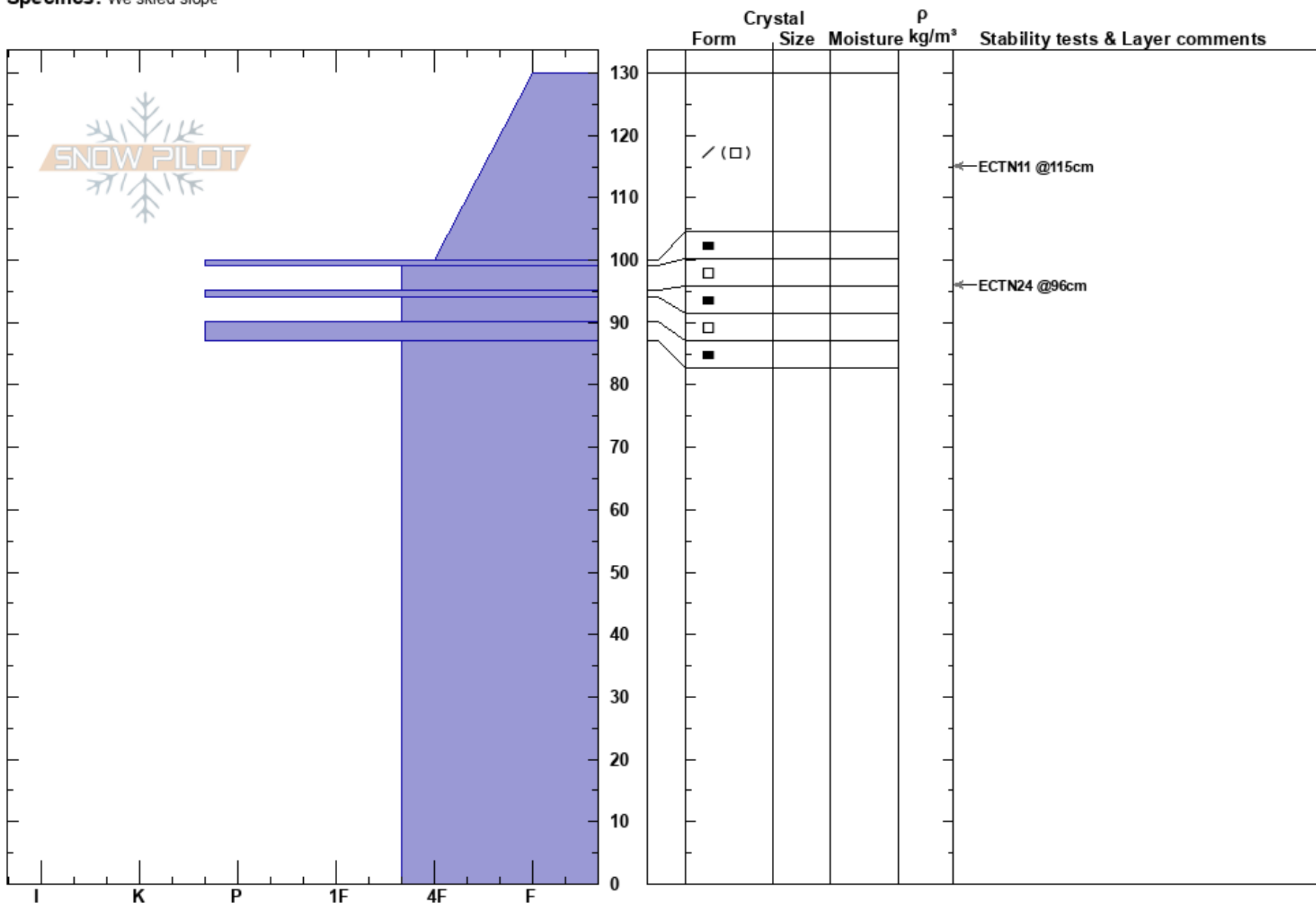

Slope appeared to have some debris on slope, likely from a very small SS release during the Christmas storm cycle.
