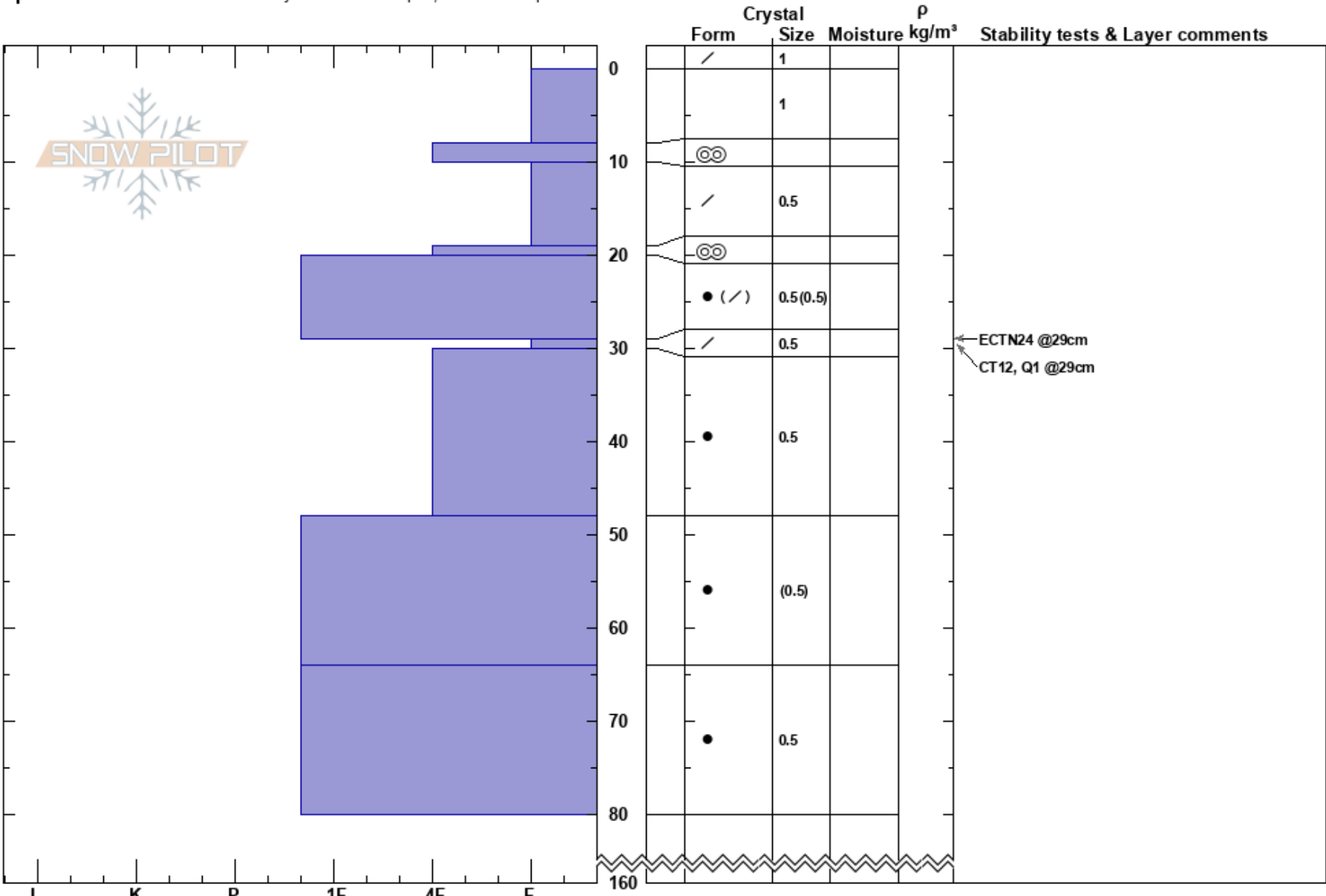

Notes: Previous W winds had scoured some W slopes and loaded E slopes. Sun crusts observed on Southerly aspects. Pit was dug on a somewhat sheltered slope so the crusts I found were not as firm as elsewhere. Generally good stability, fun surfy skiing when avoiding S aspects.
