

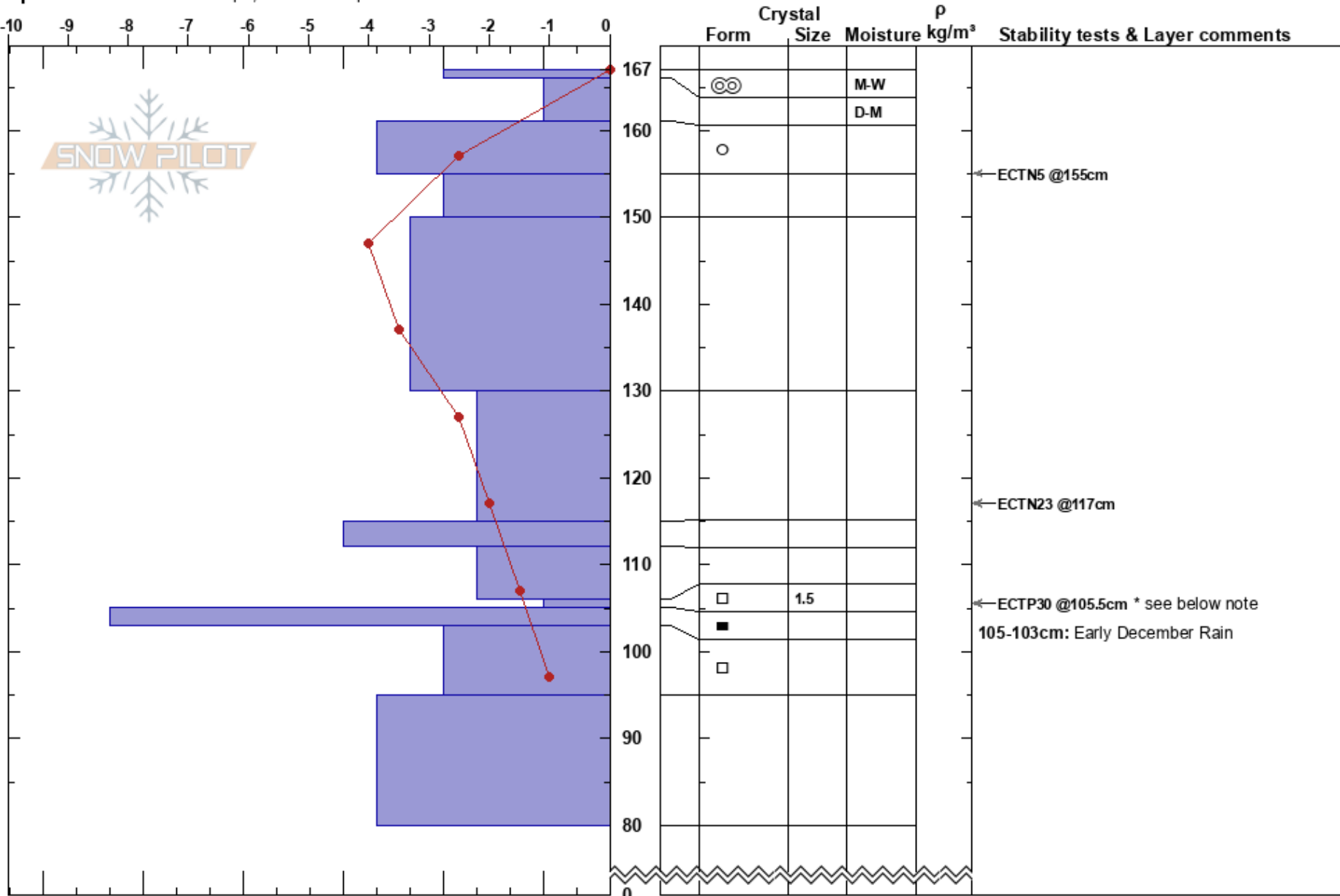

Notes: *ECTP30 @105.5: Isolated with cord down to 105cm from ground (top of knife+ rain-crust). Isolation in this snowpack is a little tough, and the isolation dimensions were off. At the bottom of the isolated column the width was 30cm on one side, and 22cm on the shovel tap side. We isolated a second ext. column (with proper dimensions) down to the same rain-crust, but could not reproduce a failure in the facet layer above the rain-crust.
