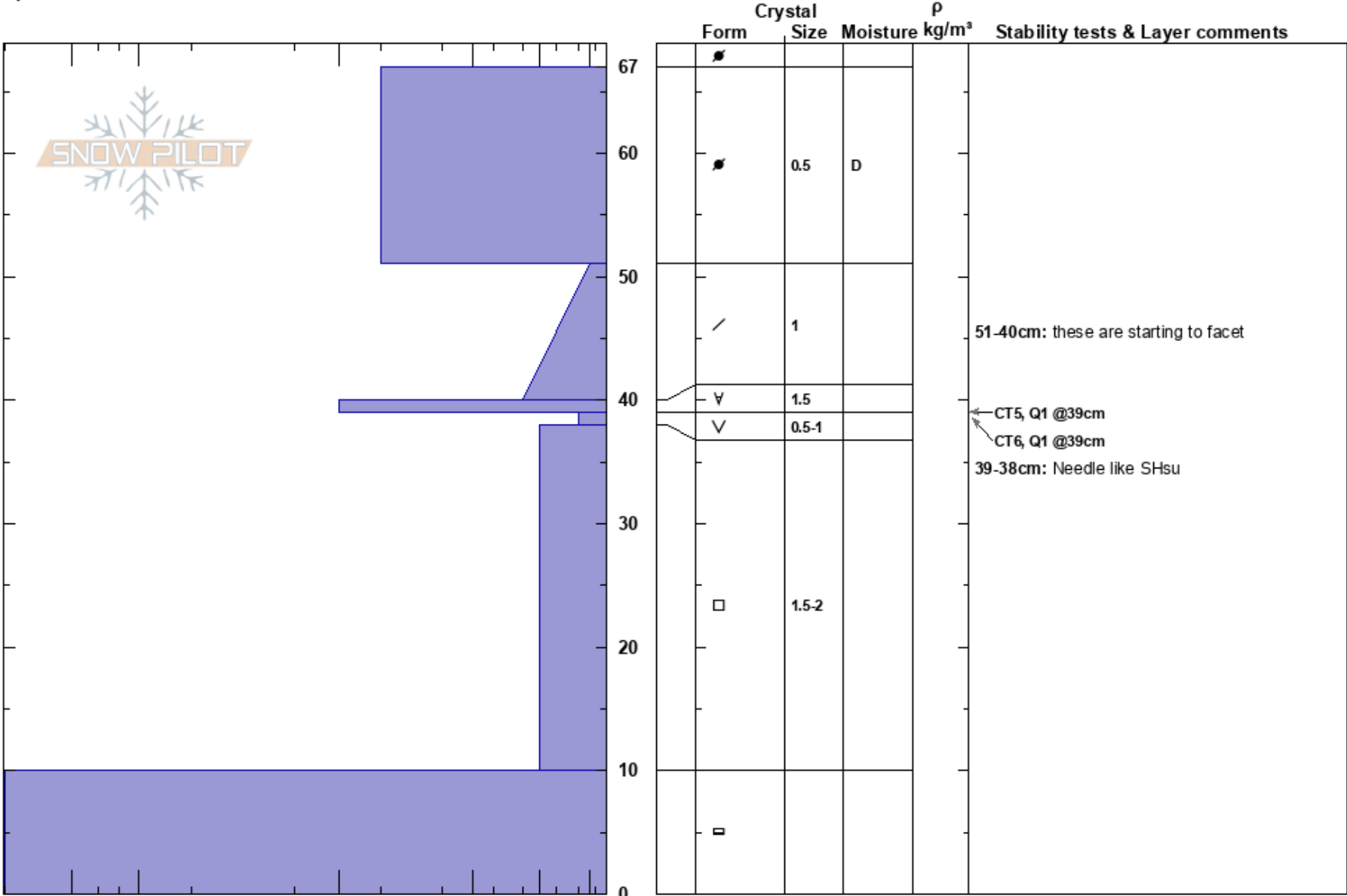

Layer Notes:

51-40cm: these are starting to facet

39-38cm: Needle like SHsu

39-38cm: Problematic layer



Notes: Quick test pit dug on towers 1 lee to the s1/4 loading of the previous 48hrs. this is representative of conditions across the summit lee to the S 1/4. 150m below the conditions change dramatically due to limited snow. Was on a control route so didn't have a saw and could not adequately isolate an ECT. Control work with explosives was never able to step below the rime crust.
