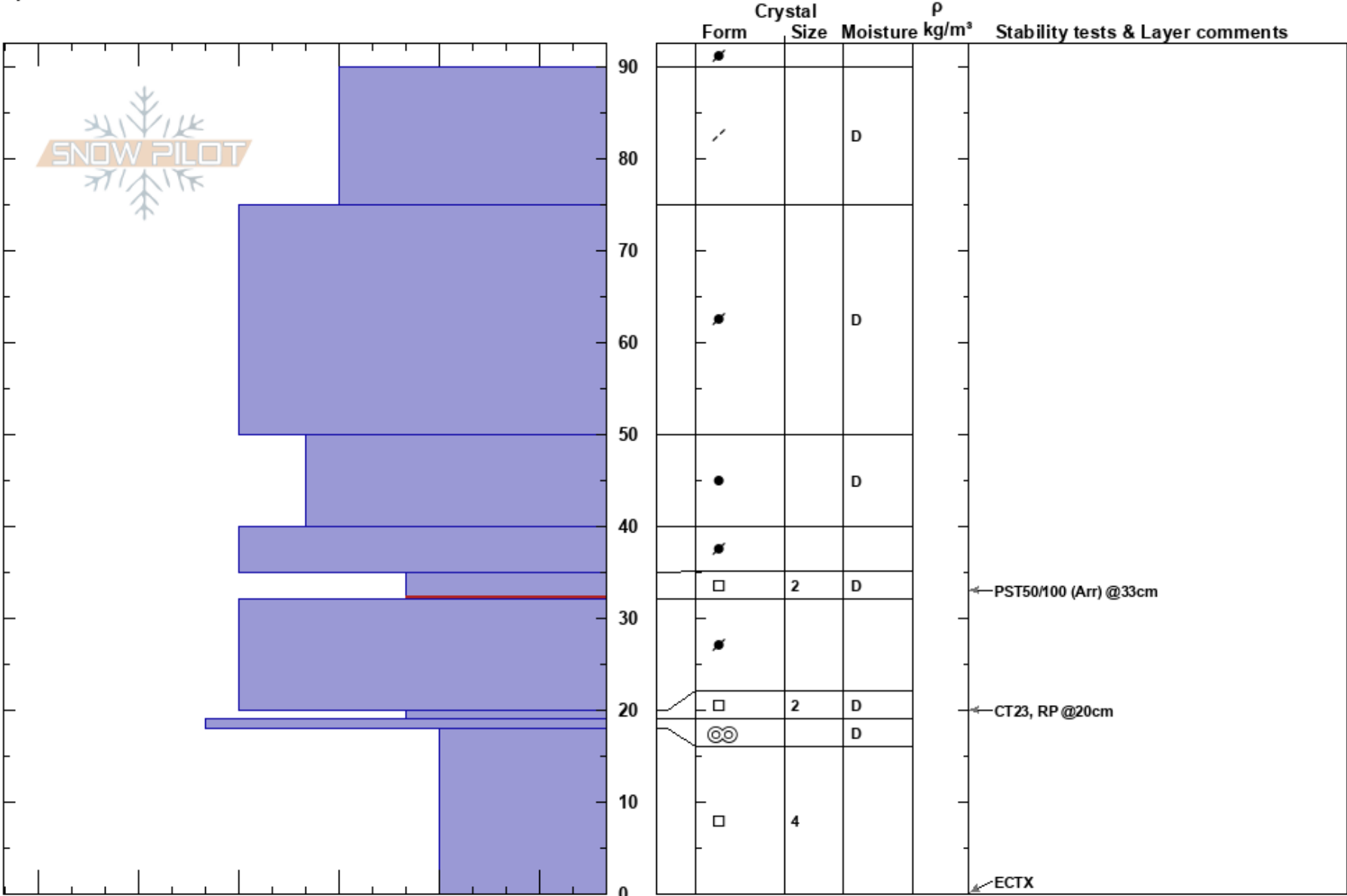

Notes: Went to investigate report of Nc Sz 2.5 Sp ~1900m that occurred on 200713 in the Doolans. Crown 50-200cm deep, 100m wide going 200m long MR. Avalanche seems to have been triggered in a shaded SW asp while we dug in the crown wall facing E which could explain ECTX.
