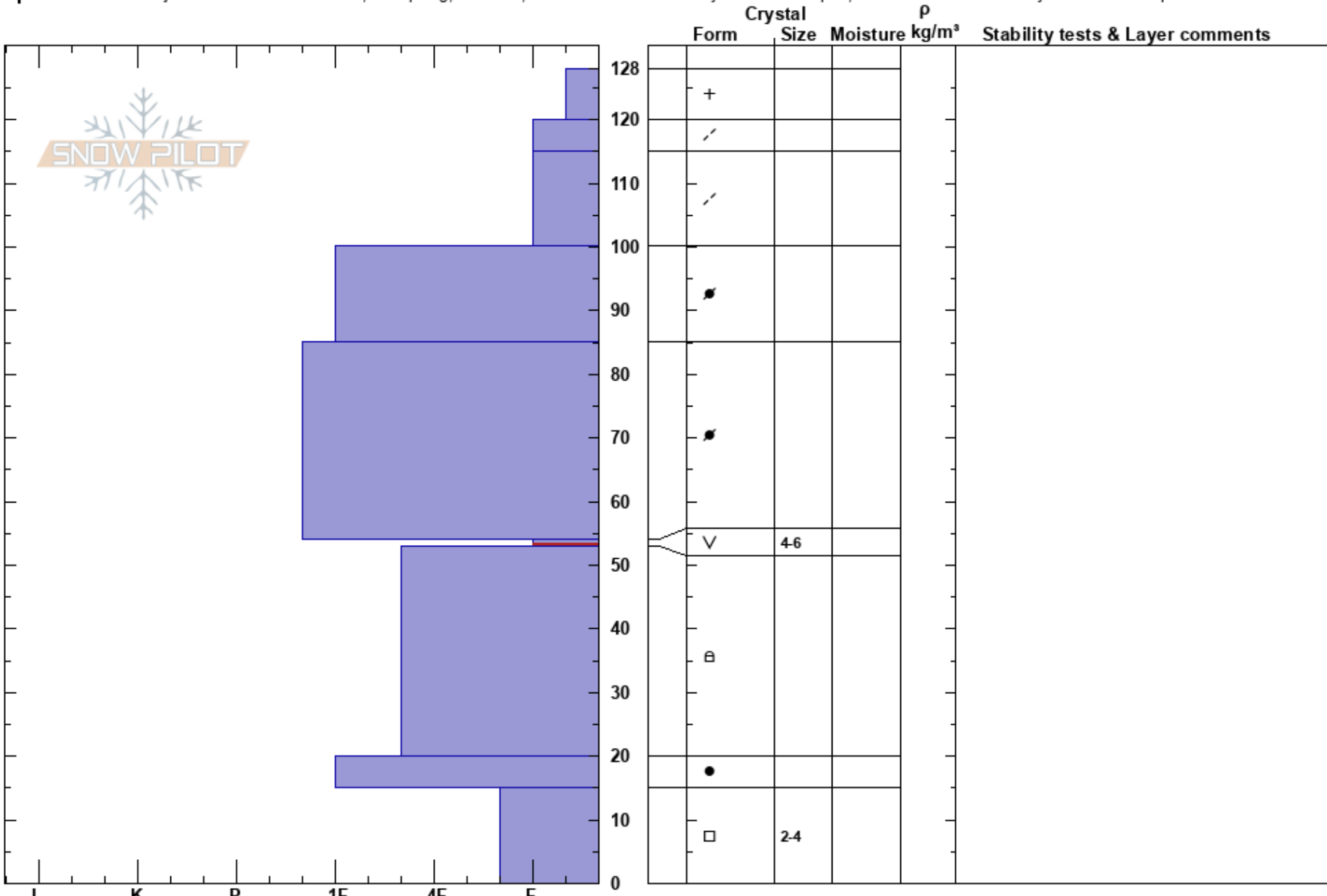

Avalanche failed on buried SH from 11/19, and stepped down to facets at the ground in some pockets on the slope. There were a ton of tracks adjacent to the avalanche, so it was tough to say whether the avalanche failed naturally or was skier-triggered.
