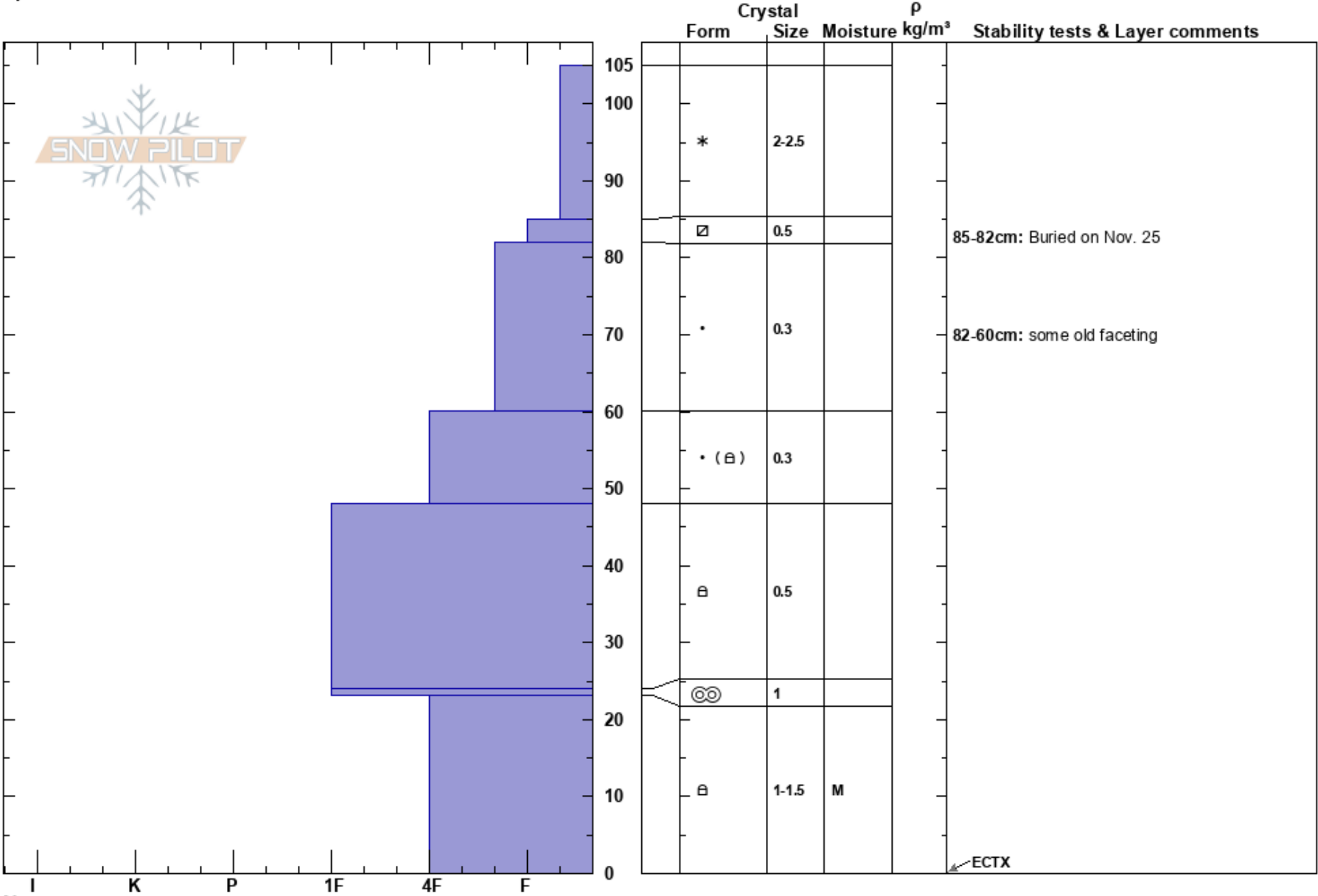

Notes: Annual Thanksgiving Pit in typical location (Far skier's left above KB Ridge). Pit observations from Sarah Carpenter. Snow depth was greater than 'average' for Thanksgiving Day at this location. No unstable snow signs and good skiing on shady aspects. Pit in similar location 10 days ago showed propagation on basal facet (ECTP23), but not today.
