

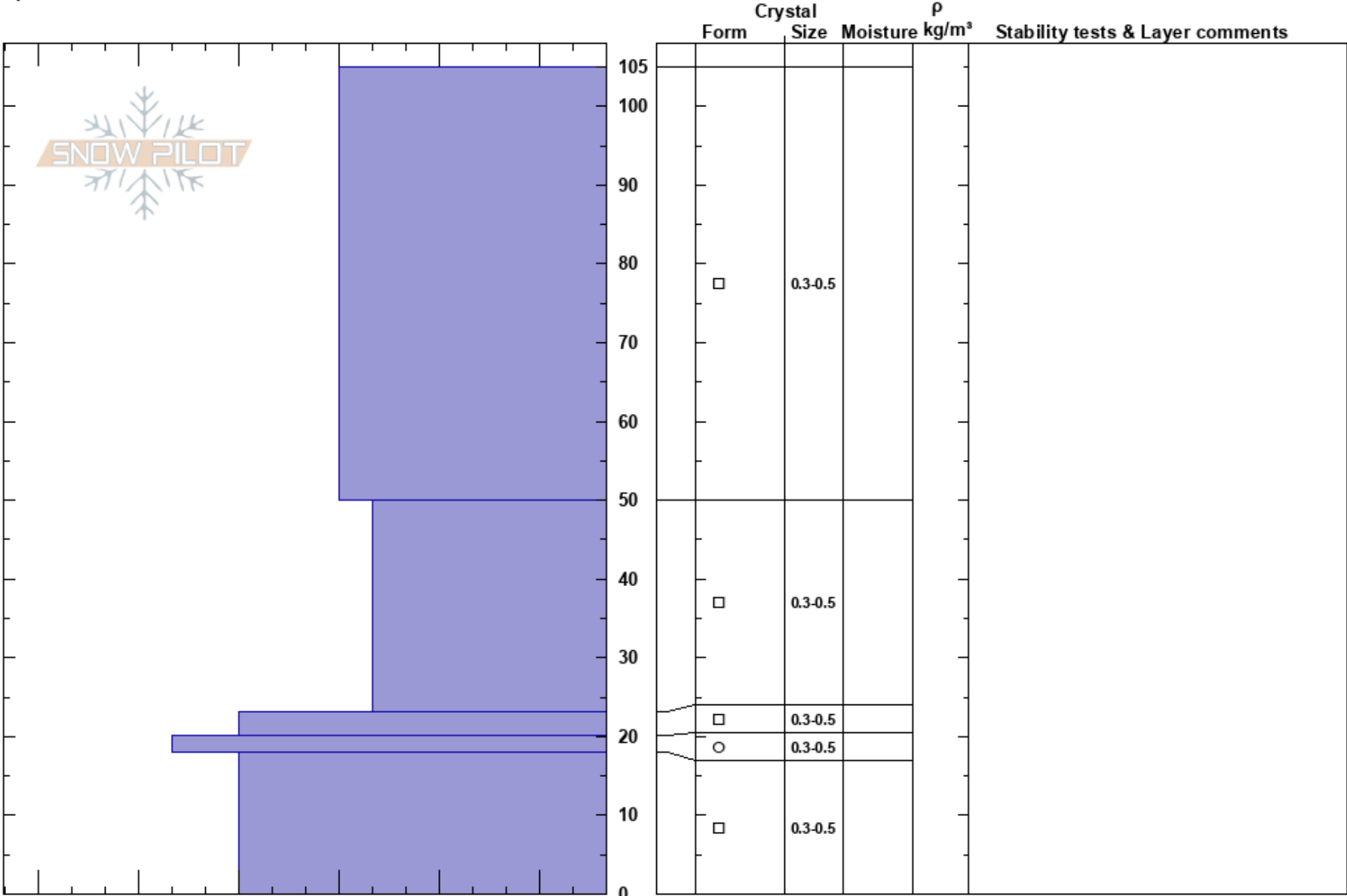

Notes: This was dug in an isolated deeper patch of wind blown snow, while most of the ridge is scoured to rock from the strong E winds. While some density changes were present, margins between layers were nebulous and the pack seemed well consolidated. The layer of concern is not that concerning, but it is a bit softer than its surroundings.
