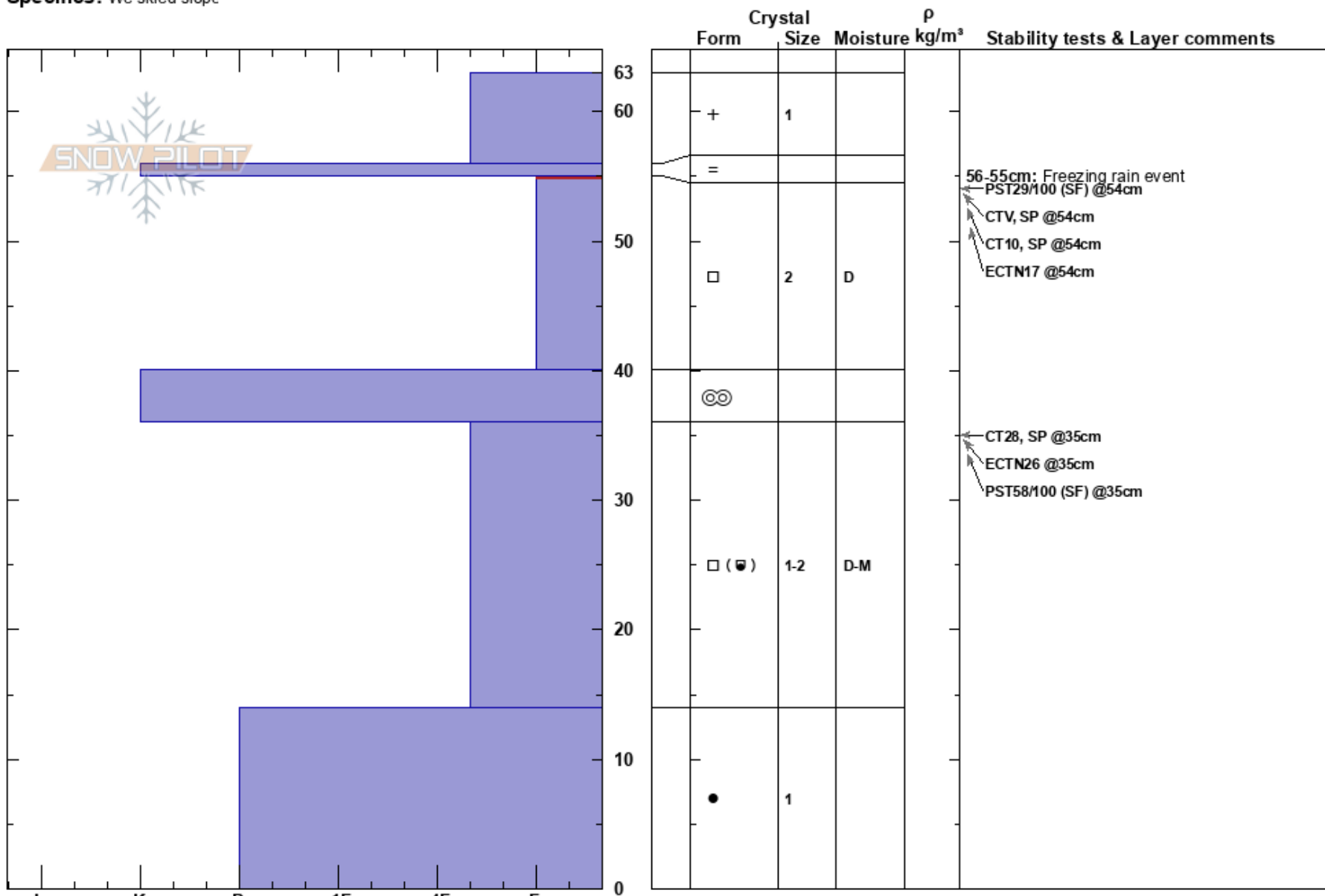

**Notes:** Pit dug on open shaded slope below treeline. PST @ 35 cm had SF into upper facet layer that then propagated to column end. Freezing rain event created crust on top of old near surface facets which are still weak. This looks like a developing PWL to be named the Dec 11 facet layer.
