

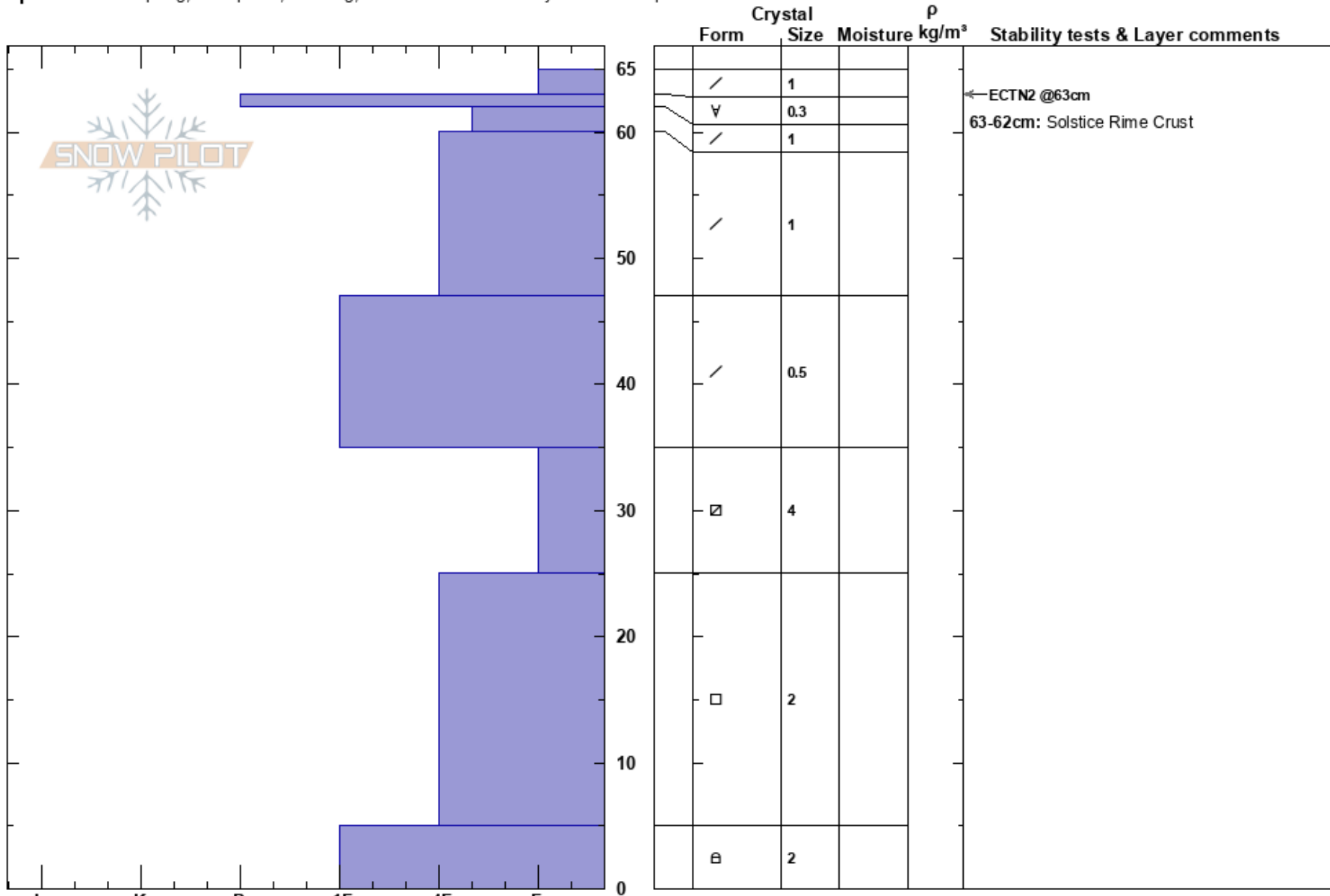

Notes: The Solstice crust exists on all slopes below about 10,000 feet. On all south slopes and most east slopes this is a sun or temperature crust. A fragile rime crust exists on Northeast through North through Northwest and is now buried under today's new snow.
