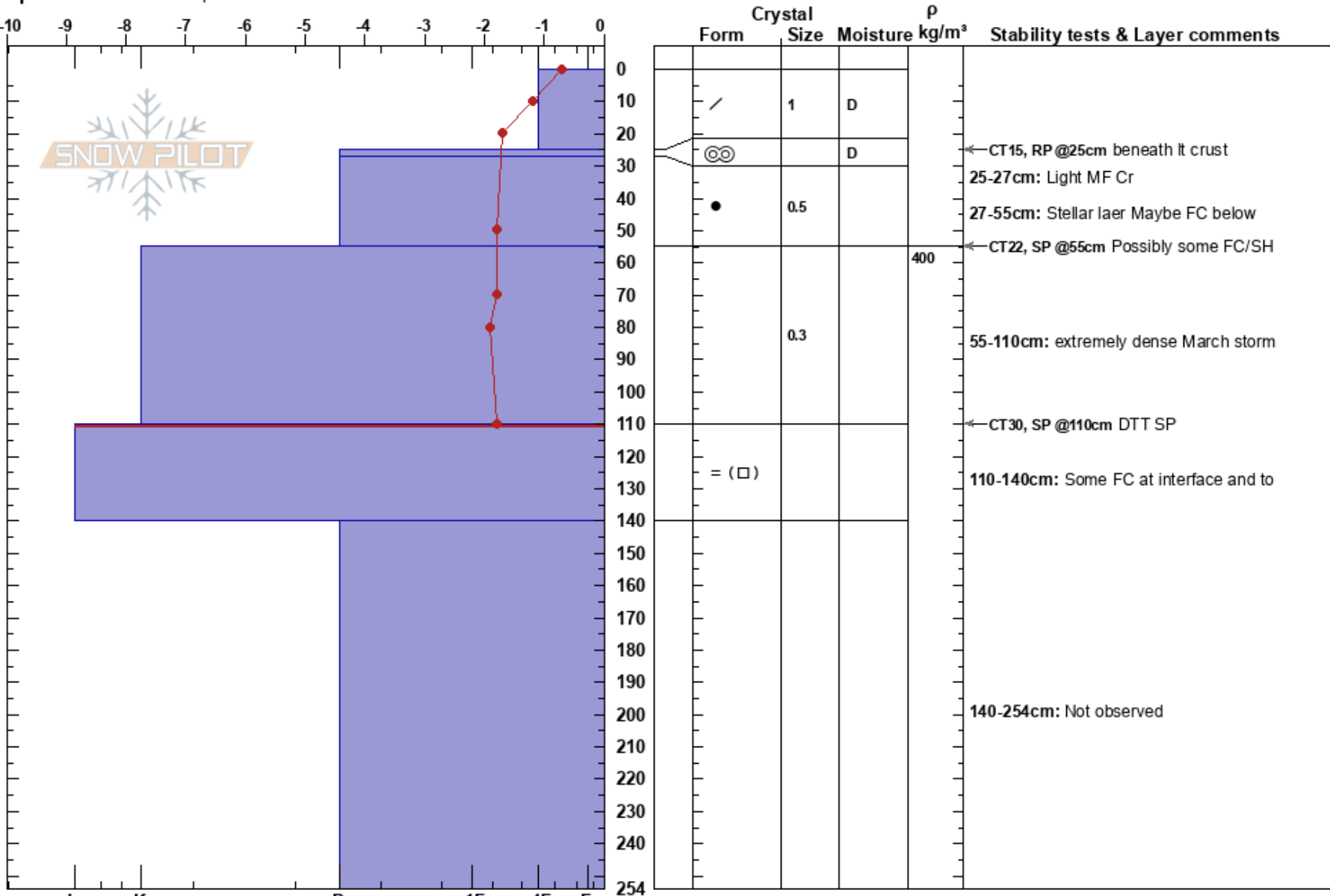

**Notes:** Clearing after recent period of storms. Little wind effect. Some storm shears and recent local small storm avalanches in local lees. Mid Feb at 110 down. FC chains rounding DTT Sp at 22, Ice crust still not penetrable by shovel. Evidence of MF cycle in recent warming below 1500m. Additional Layer Comments: 254-140cm: Not observed;
