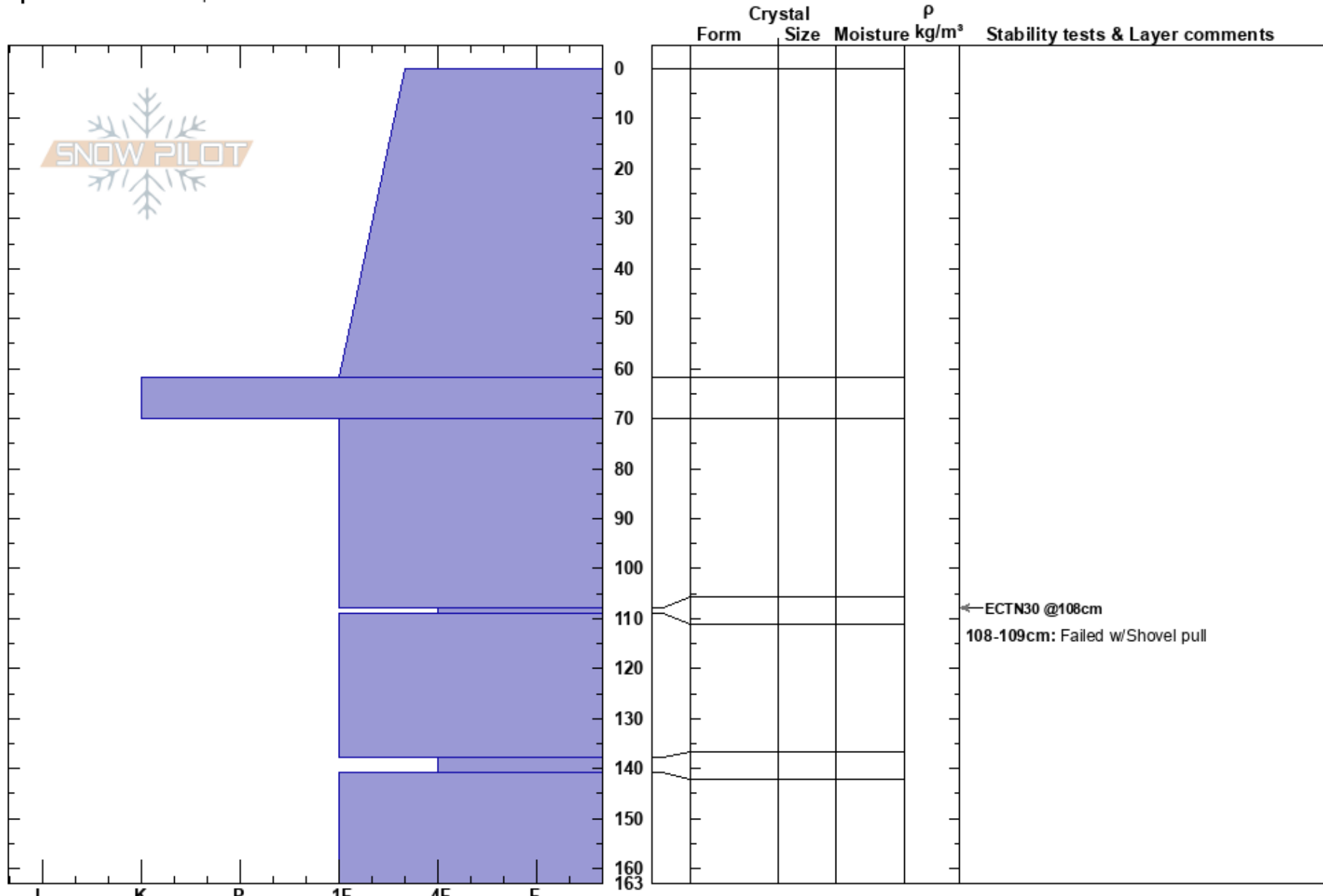

Notes: Surprised with an ECTN. The ECT did fail after the test with a real hard shovel pull. It broke across the column @ 108cm. Potentially getting deep enough to make that weak layer from earlier this year hard to trigger but the snowpack still has a ton of energy. We stuck to low angle skiing.
 Didn't find any instability surrounding the upper 'knife' layer.
 Moderate winds on the ridge, we got off the ridge and away from the wind slab for the pit.
