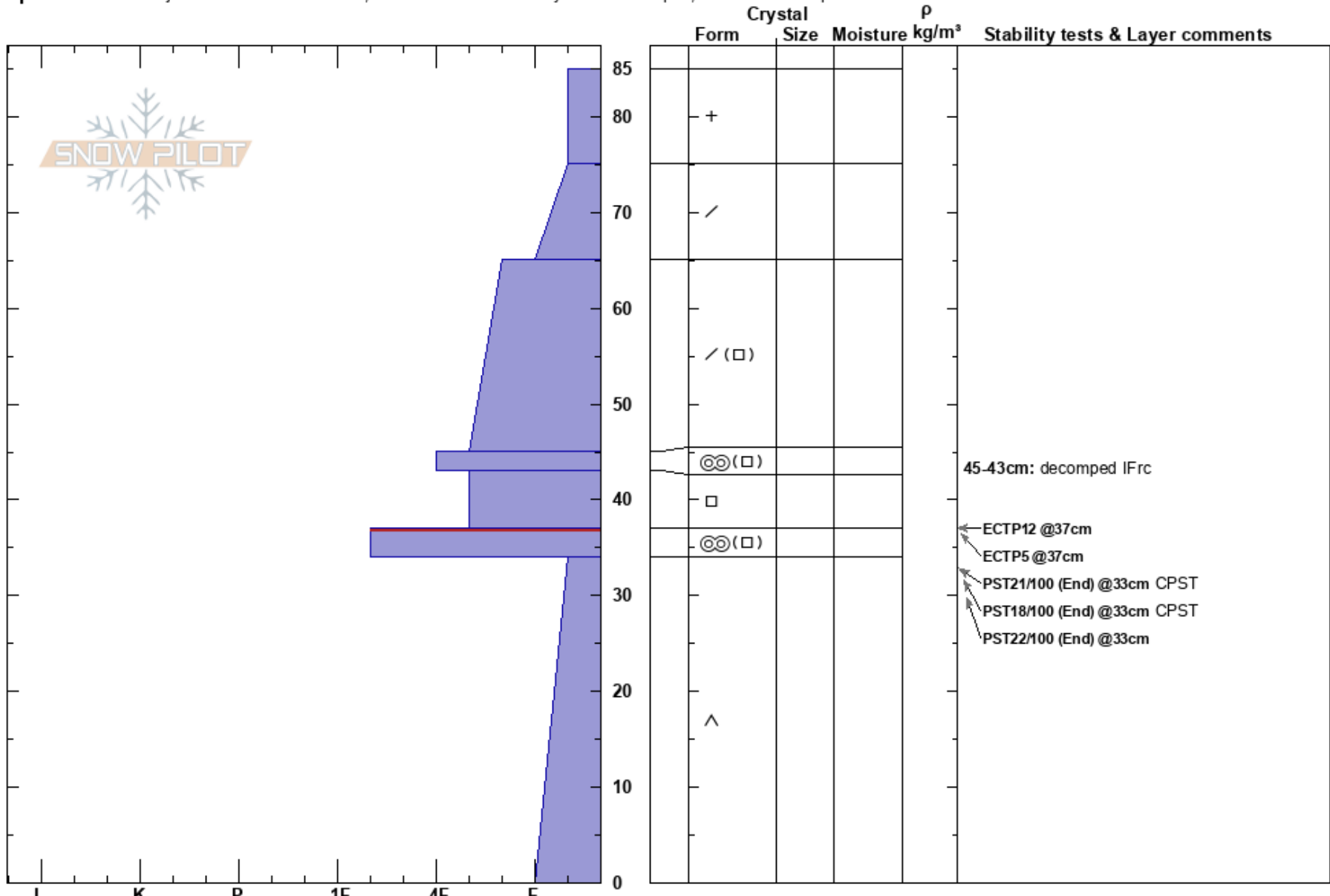

Notes: Thin weak layers aren't great candidates for PST/CPST. Out of curiosity, I performed these tests on top of depth hoar, below the crust. Avalanche and ECTs failed on 1-2mm FC on top of crust. Slope angle on bed surface ranged from 36-40°, slope quickly eased below.
