

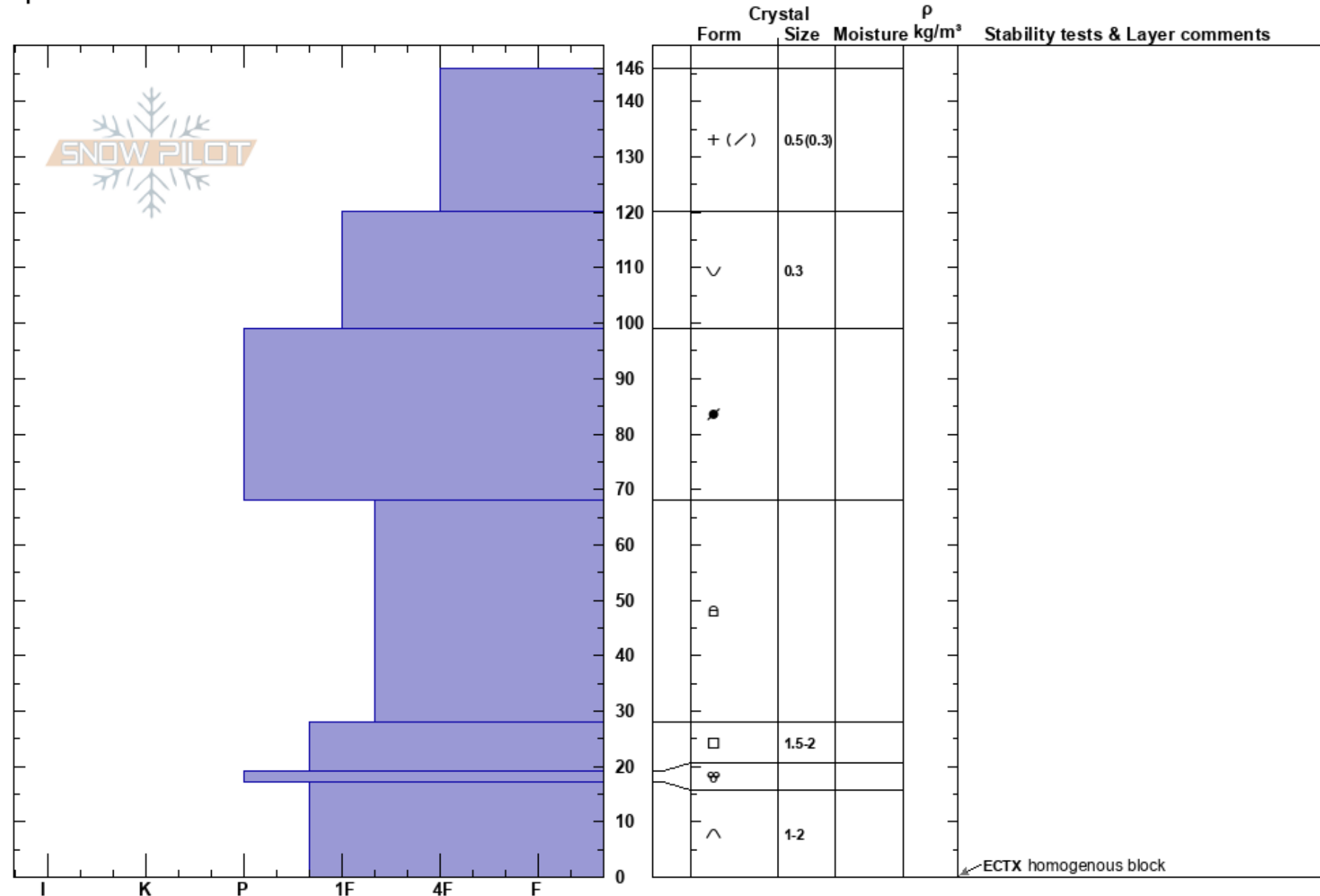

Notes: Slope was wind hammered. Sastrugi. Snow in pit was clearly worked by the wind. Lots of smaller forms of all grain types. I did a shovel shear after the ECTX and the column slid out like a slow file drawer. Q3 BRK that started at 22cm and went down to the ground. I didn't ski the slope, but only because the conditions would have been horrible. Stability seemed bomber.
