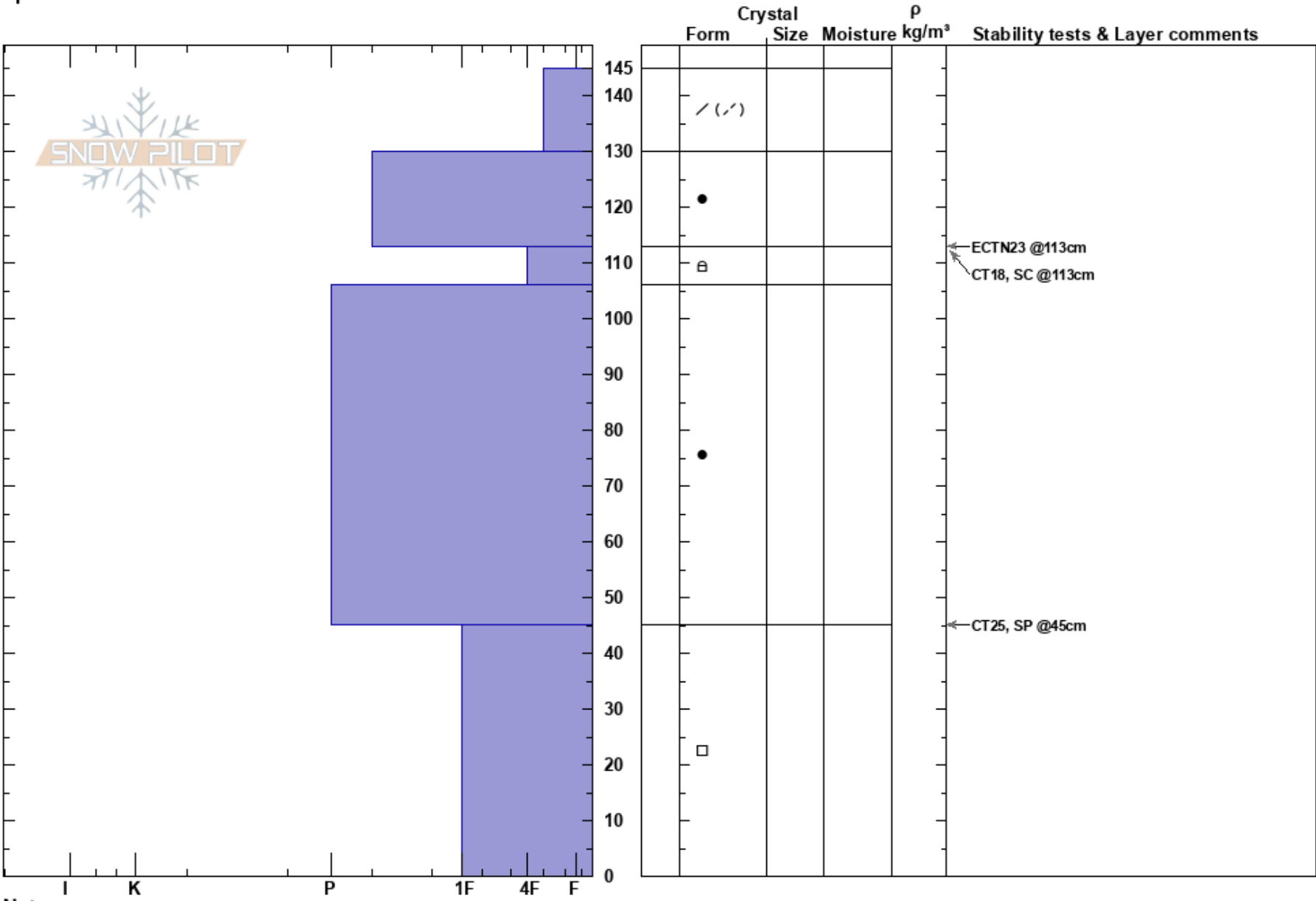

Notes: The weakest interface is >1m deep in the snowpack, but several weak interfaces persist in the upper snowpack as well. A slide triggered in the upper layers would likely step down to the deepest weak layer, resulting in a very large and dangerous avalanche.
