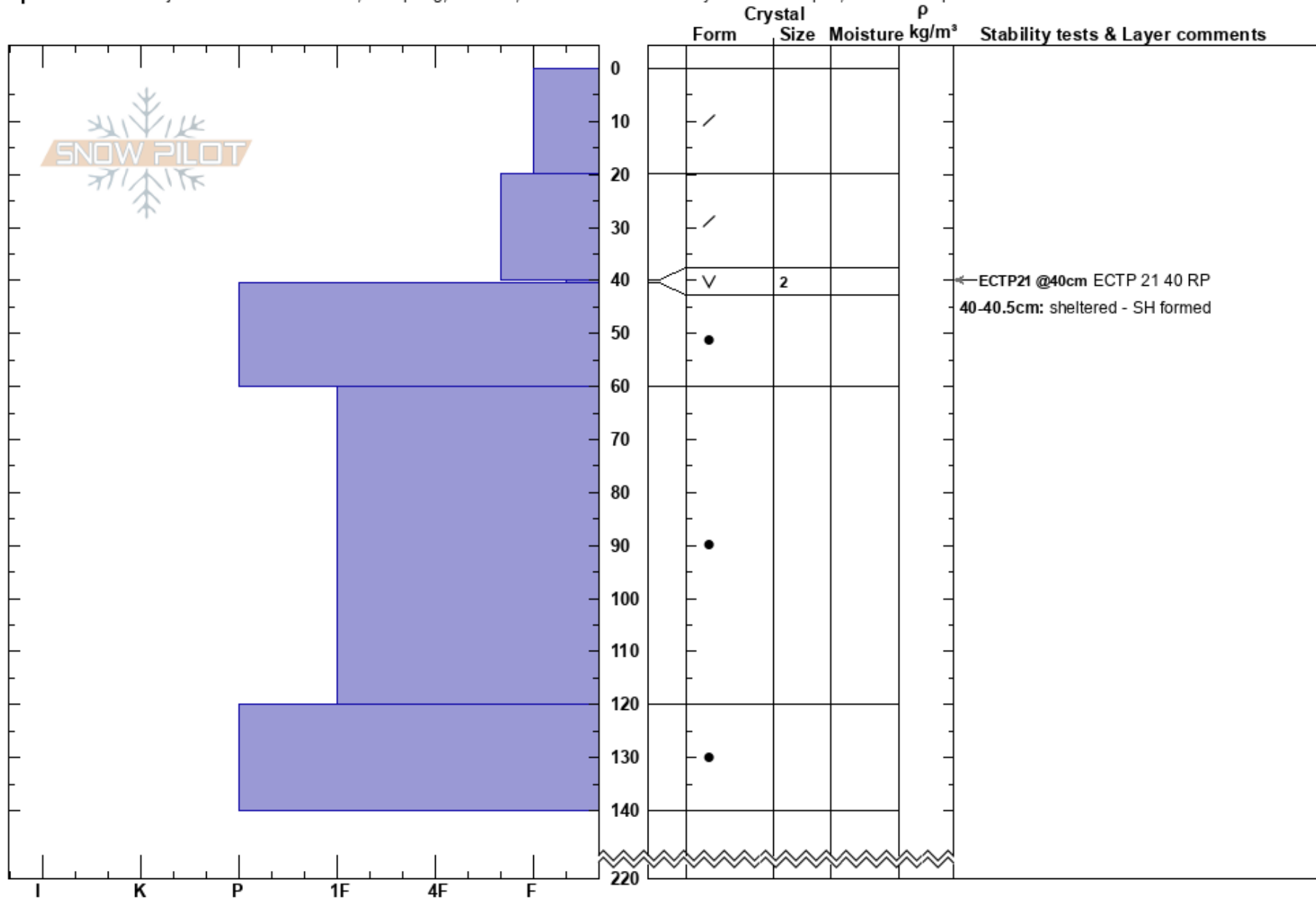

**Specifics:** Pit is adjacent to avalanche: other; Collapsing, localized; Recent avalanche activity on similar slopes; We skied slope



**Notes:** Dug pit out and below ridgecrest after triggering .5 Sst (soft) by touching face with skis.

Skied to safe location below ridgecrest and noticed large loud settlement. suspect it was on the buried SH as pack was too deep to have reactive PWL.
