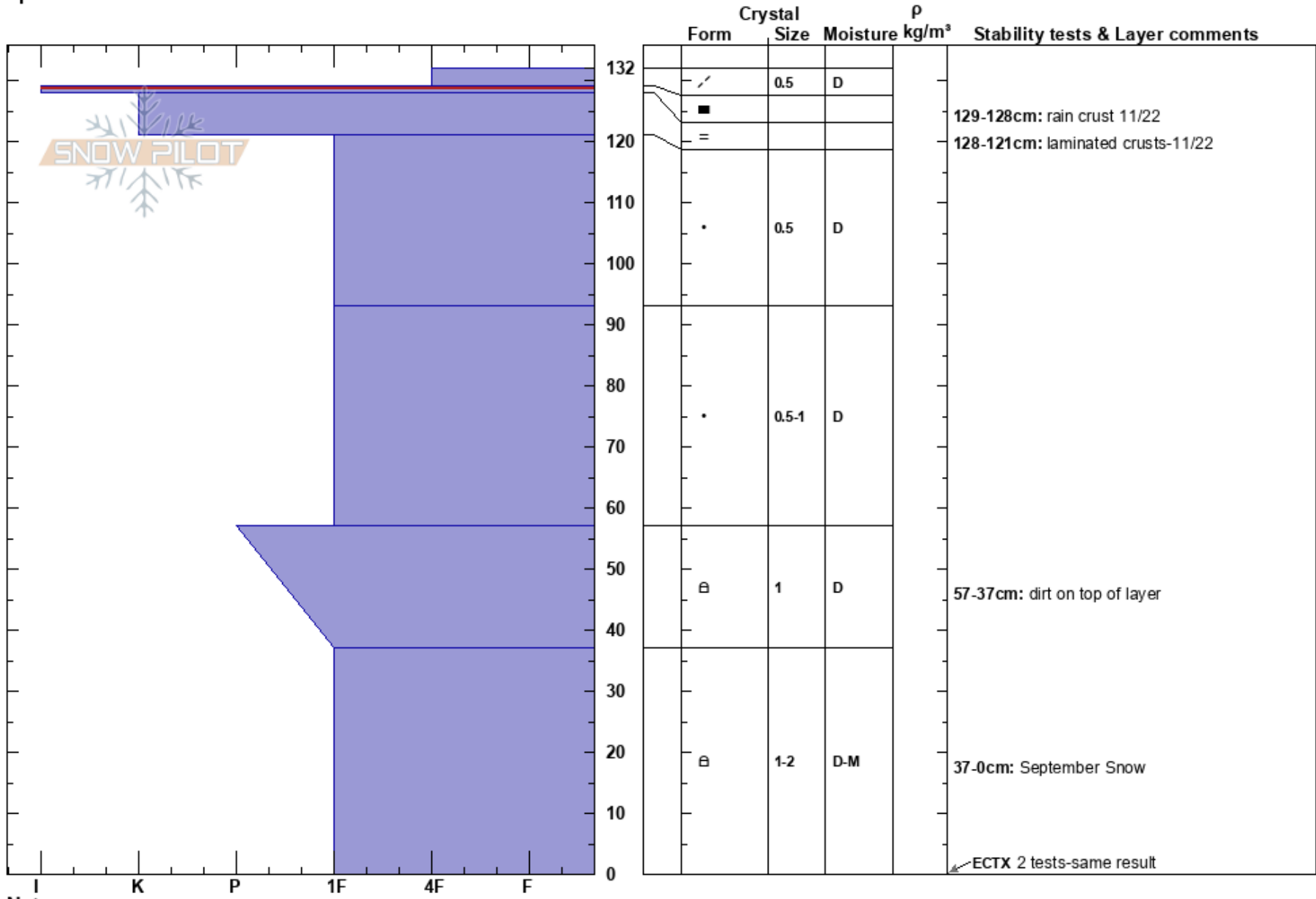

Notes: 100' from Glory summit on the breakover. This is a standard pit location for observing early season snowpack structure. We dug near here in early October and were tracking some basal facets at that point. Today they are rounding and well bonded to the snow above. Even when the ECT column tipped over into the pit it wouldn't break :
