

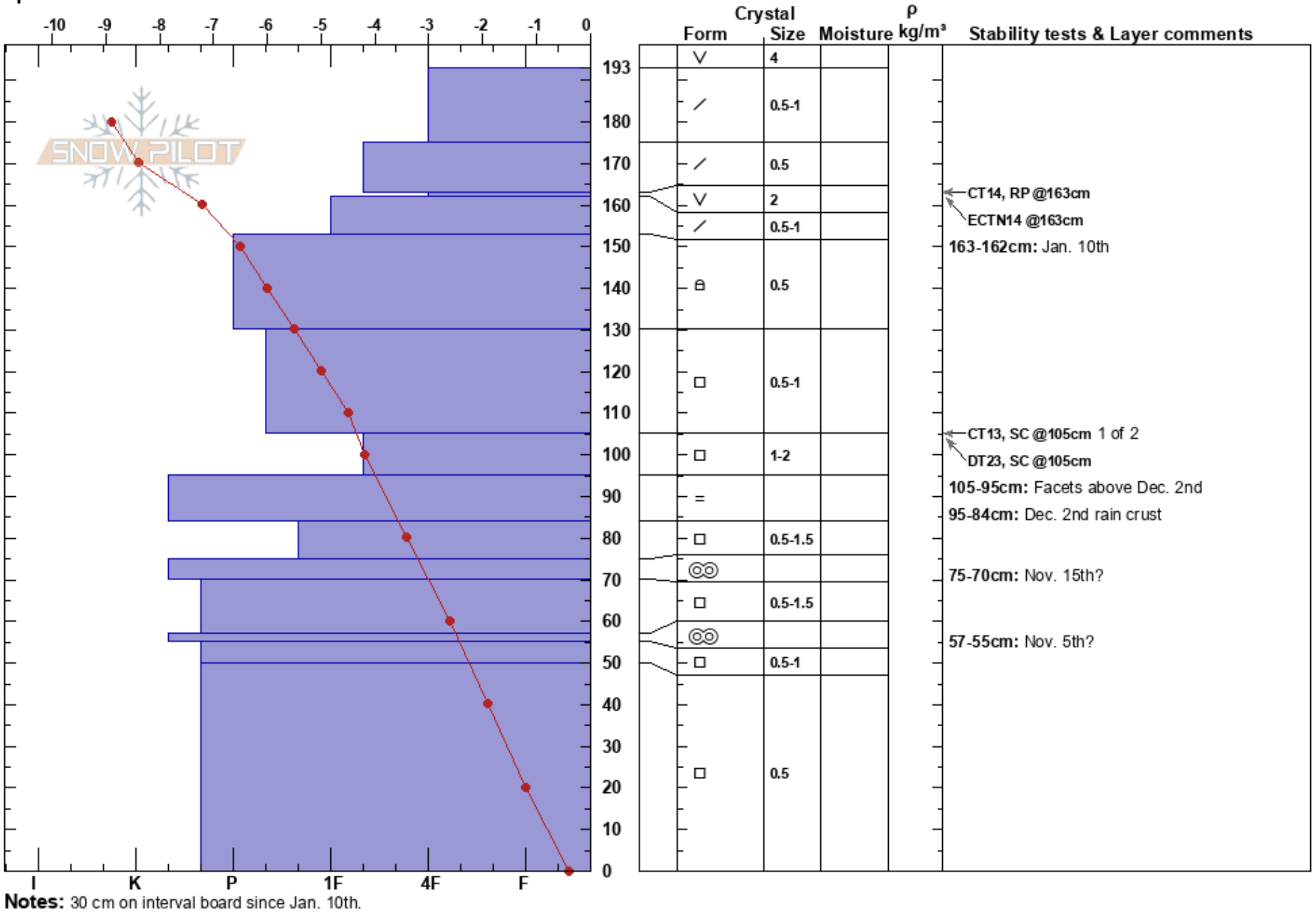

We also dug a little lower on a 35 degree NE aspect at 1950m and found a similar depth but generally weaker snowpack and got 4 x CTE 1 (SC) down 115cm on facets above the Dec. 2nd rain crust.. Additional Layer Comments: 55-57cm: Nov. 5th?;
