

Specifics: Pit is adjacent to avalanche: other; Collapsing, widespread; Collapsing, localized; Cracking; Recent avalanche activity on similar slopes



Notes: Dug pit just below fresh (natural) avalanche debris, likely from the night before. Widespread whumpfing and shooting cracks in the mid-elevations. Remote triggered a small avalanche from 150 - 200' away. Facets over MF crust was obvious weak layer. Some of the more reactive snow I've ever seen!
