

Notes: Wind direction changed significantly throughout the day. Prevailing wind direction throughout the morning was W, but swirling wind at the time of recording was coming from the SE.

Compression Test had poor construction, which may have skewed the results. There was reason to suspect ski tracks in the pit wall, which also may have contributed ETC and CT results.

Finally, there was a crust layer at the interface of 29cm, which I neglected to record in my notebook.
