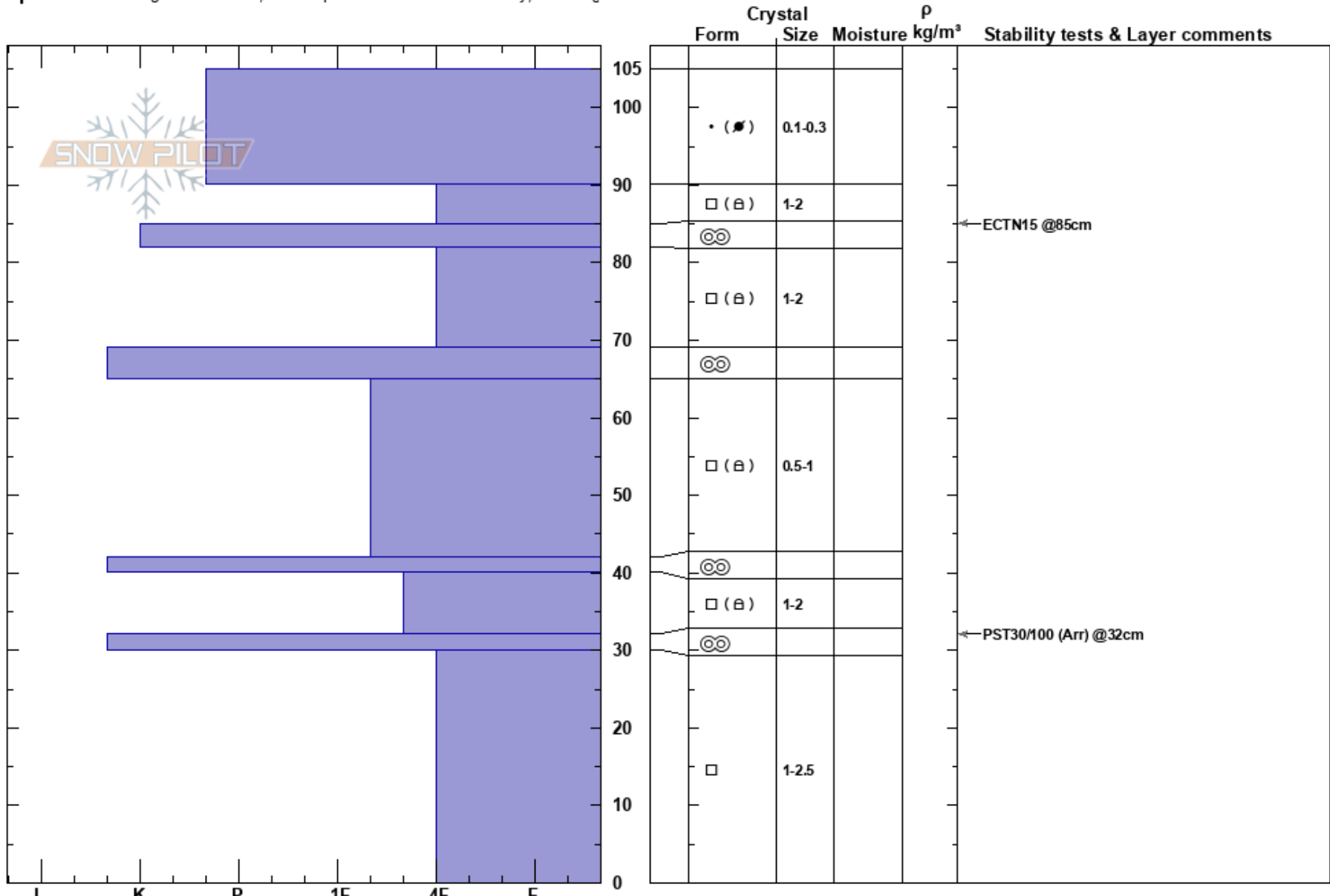

**Notes:** This profile has multiple layers of concern. All the crust/facet combinations are troublesome. The crusts are 3 to 4 cm thick and very supportable. Each could be a bed surface on its own. However, future loading will determine which one and how deep failure occurs. It seems this matrix could support quite a bit of weight before it goes.
