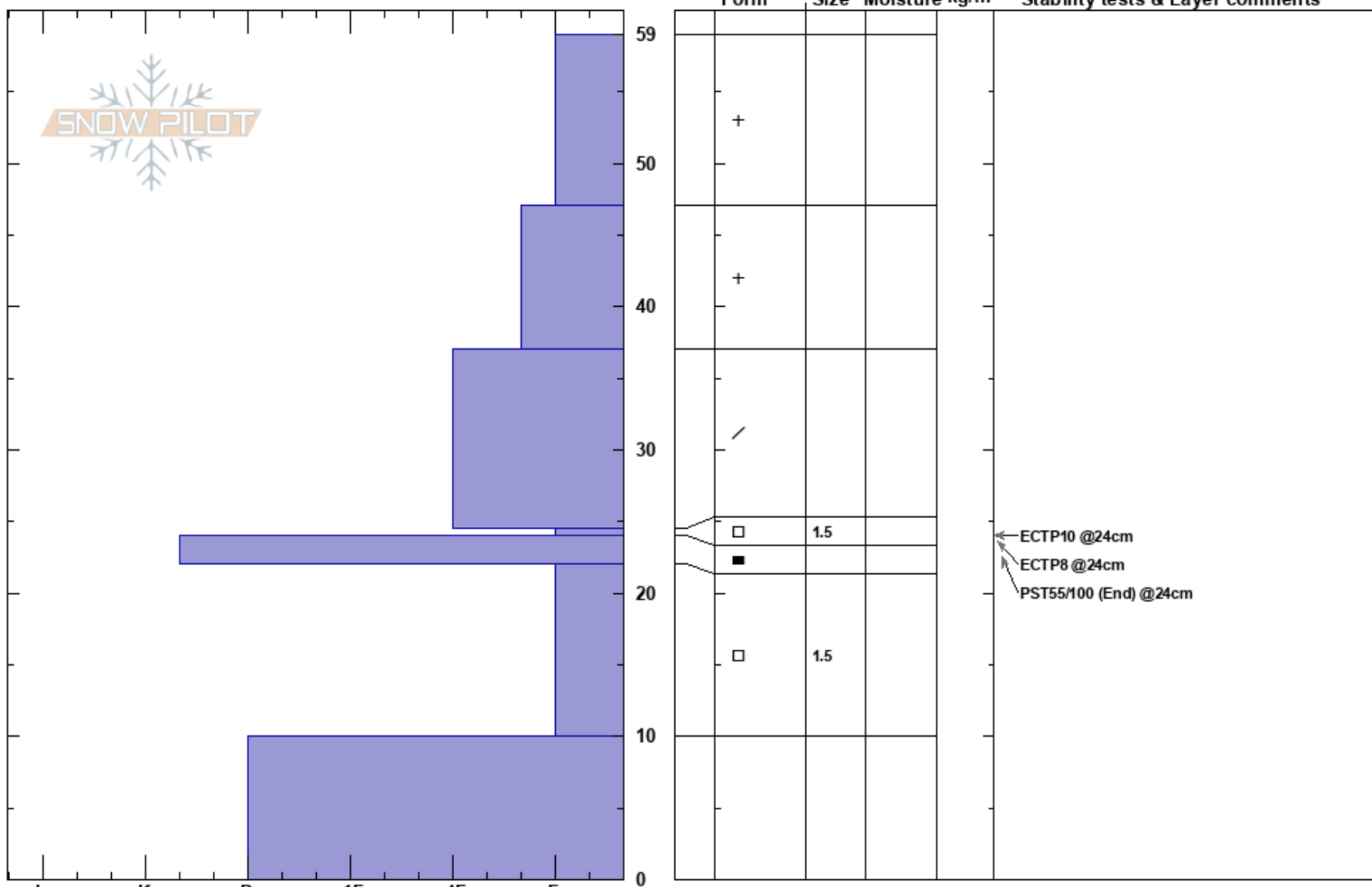

**Notes:** Facets just above the Thanksgiving crust surprised me how readily they popped with only light wrist taps in the ECT. This layer isn't everywhere because strong winds blew before it was capped with new snow on Dec 3. These winds likely removed this layer on top of the crust. No matter, the next week of high pressure and cold temps will create more weak layers and facets.
