

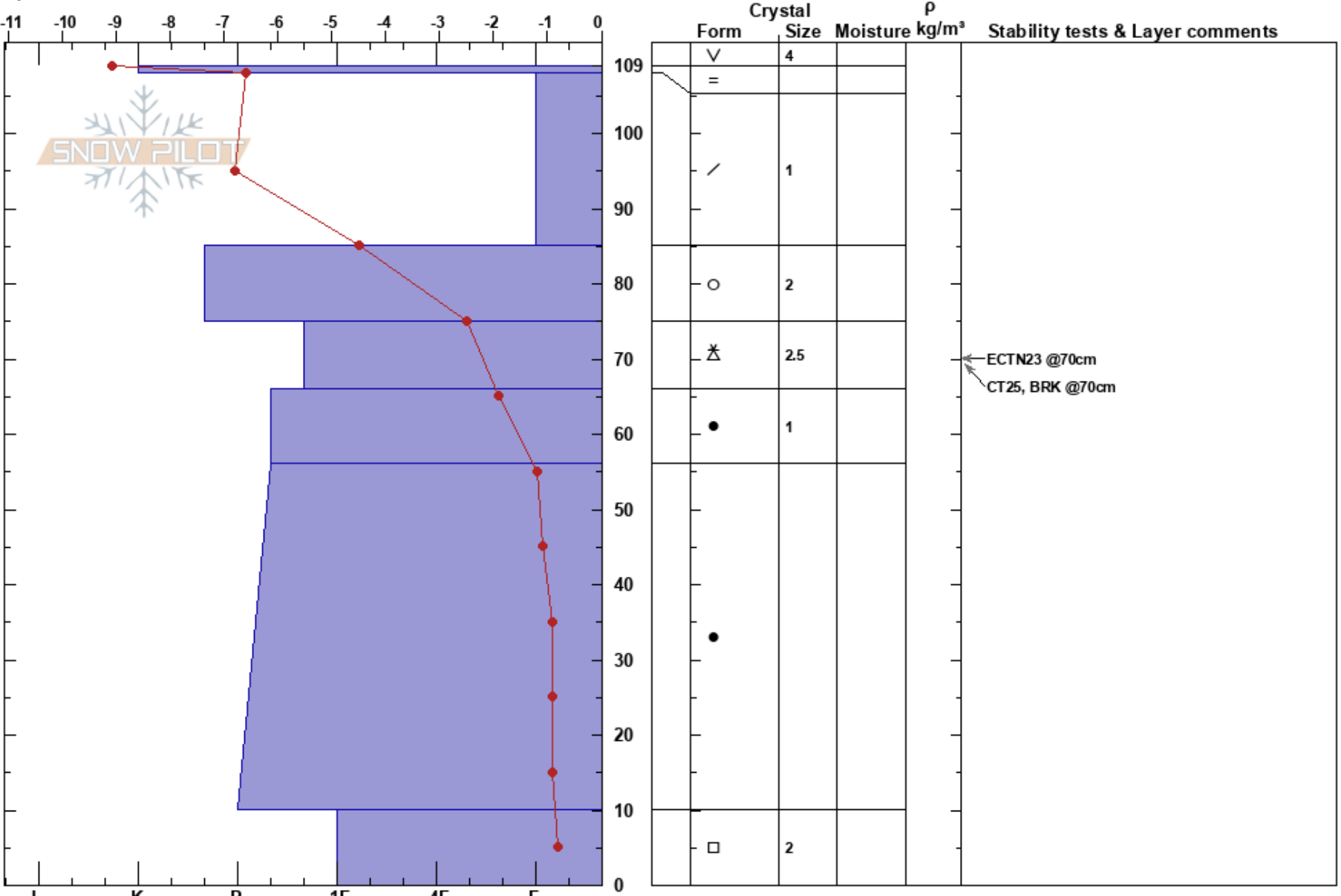

75-66cm: Problematic layer



Notes: Facets at ground are around tussock. In other places, basal ice. Low concern.
Graupel layer variable across slope in distribution and thickness.
Generally very stable pack. Breakable crust is the only concern for poor skiing.
This could be near surface or where pack is shallow; depth.
With forecasted clear weather in the next few days, monitor pack for faceting occurring from very cold temps and steep gradient
